GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division referred this matter to the Office of General Counsel because of the Committee's failure to timely disclose contributions in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3).

EVIDENCE

The 30-day Post General Election Report for Rooney for Congress disclosed several expenditures in October and November, 1978 relative to a testimonial dinner, but did not indicate any receipts from the dinner. The Committee's April 10, 1979 quarterly report disclosed gross receipts of \$6,085 from a "Fred Rooney Nite Testimonial Dinner" held on October 27, 1978 and broke down the receipts to indicate that \$4,935 was from tickets purchased by individuals and \$1,150 was from tickets purchased by political committees. The report also itemized all the individuals whose purchases exceeded \$100 and all the political committees which contributed, and listed the totals on the Detailed Summary Page.

On May 17, 1979, two RFAI's were sent to the Committee. One questioned the absence of any dinner receipts on the 30-day Post General Election Report; and the other questioned why the proceeds of an October, 1978 dinner had appeared only on the April 10, 1979 report. The Committee submitted a response on May 25, 1979 indicating that the dinner receipts, "were reported when delivered to the Treasurer during the 30-day period ending March 31, 1979." Based on an examination of the report, all of the itemized contributions were delivered on March 7, 1979. The response did not indicate who delivered these contributions to the Treasurer.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

Sections 434(b)(2) and (3) of the Act require that contributors who contribute in excess of \$100 and the total sum of individual contributions of less than \$100 during a reporting period, be reported in the report covering that period. See also Section 104.2(b) of the Commission's Regulations.

It seems unlikely that ticket purchases for an event such as the Rooney Dinner would have been made after the event, and the Committee's response states only that the reporting of the proceeds occurred at the time the proceeds were delivered to the Treasurer. While the Committee may have met its §434(b) responsibility in promptly and fully reporting such proceeds when it received them, §434(b)(3) of the Act, the Section which was the basis for this referral to the Office of General Counsel, does not precisely address the issue of transmittal of the contributions to the Treasurer.

The Commission's Regulations do set out requirements for prompt transmittal and deposit of contributions to a committee's account. Section 103.3(a) of the Regulations requires deposit of contributions in the appropriate campaign depository within ten days of the candidate's or treasurer's receipt thereof. Section 101.3 requires that a candidate who wishes to be relieved of personal reporting responsibilities to surrender to his/her committee within five (5) days contributions personally received. This Section also provides that the candidate not commingle such personally received contributions with his own funds. Section 110.6 deals with the duties imposed on a conduit. Whether these provisions apply depends on the identity of the transmittor of the funds and the circumstances of the transmittal. Given these questions, and considering the apparently full, albeit late, reporting of the dinner proceeds, we think the matter should be referred back to RAD. To complete the record, RAD should question the Treasurer as to the identity of the person who collected the proceeds and delivered them to the Treasurer, when the proceeds were first obtained, whether the original contributor checks were delivered to the Committee or whether the funds were passed through another account, and the reasons for the delay in the transmittal. If a further referral is then considered necessary, it could be handled as a new matter.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Direct that this matter be referred back to the Reports Analysis Division for it to question respondent committee as to the identity of the person who collected the proceeds and delivered them to the treasurer; when the proceeds were first obtained; whether the original contributor checks were delivered to the Committee, or whether the funds were passed through another account; and the reasons for the delay in the transmittal.
