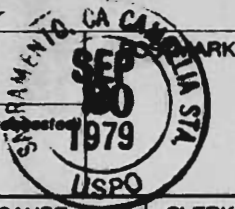

On September 10, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that your association violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b by contributing \$200 to the Fazio for Congress Committee on September 12, 1978.

Our information is that your organization is incorporated and section 441b of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, prohibits contributions to federal committees by corporations. However, we note that the Fazio for Congress Committee has advised us that this contribution has been returned to you.

Therefore, after considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission has determined to take no further action and close its file. In this regard, you should be aware that contributions made in violation of the Act may result in the imposition of civil penalties against the violators.



GENERATION OF MATTER

On August 10, 1979, the Fazio for Congress Committee (the Committee) was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) for receipt of a corporate contribution in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b.

EVIDENCE

On their October 10, 1978, Quarterly Report the Committee reported the receipt of a \$200 contribution from the Sacramento Valley Pharmaceutical Association (the Association) on September 12, 1978. The Committee was informed it may have accepted a corporate contribution via a surface violation letter dated March 9, 1979.

The Committee treasurer, Timothy Howe, responded by letter on March 20, 1979. Mr. Howe said the Committee would refund the \$200 on March 26, 1979. He further stated that upon receipt of the contribution, a phone call was made and that he was assured the association was not a corporation.

The refund was disclosed on a later report.

PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §441b prohibits any corporation from making a contribution in connection with any election to any political office. It further prohibits any person from accepting or receiving any corporate contributions.

However, here the contribution was assumed to be from an association (which apparently is also incorporated) after the Committee treasurer made an effort to establish the source of these funds and was assured it was not corporate.

Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends the Commission find reason to believe both respondents violated 2 U.S.C. §441b and close the file.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe Fazio for Congress may have violated 2 U.S.C. §441b.
2. Find reason to believe the Sacramento Valley Pharmaceutical Association may have violated 2 U.S.C. §441b.
3. Take no further action against either respondent.
4. Close the file.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the October 10 Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed an entry indicating that you may have accepted a contribution from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted a prohibited contribution that you return the full amount to the donor. The return should be reported immediately by letter and should include the identification of the source of this contribution or incorrect, on the original report, please submit clarification by amending your original report by letter.




