GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT


On December 4, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that the Shriver for President Committee (Committee) violated 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12) by failing to report the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by the Committee, and §434(a) by failing to file reports since the July 1978, quarterly. In response to this finding, the Committee filed six reports, including the 1979 year-end report. All these reports include information concerning the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by the Committee. By filing these reports, the Committee is in substantial compliance with the Act. Inasmuch as the Committee has filed the necessary reports, and has complied with the audit findings approved by the Commission on November 16, 1979, it is the recommendation of the Office of the General Counsel that the Commission take no further action in this matter and close the file. This course of action is consistent with the Commission's determination on October 10, 1979 in NF 224 wherein the Commission voted to take no further action against the Shriver for President Committee for not filing its October, 1978 and 1978 year end reports.

It would appear, therefore, that the only reports which the Commission believes the Committee still has failed to file are the October 10, 1978 Report and the 1978 Year-End Report, dated January 31, 1979. Mr. Spatz, the Treasurer of the Committee, advises me that he has copies of these reports in his files. However, because of his personal professional commitments, he will not be able to send me copies of these reports for a few days.

You suggest in your letter that certain reports filed by the Committee do not include sufficient information regarding the Committee's debts. We were surprised to learn of this

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

This matter was initiated by a complaint (see attached)
filed by W.D. Cannon, Secretary/Treasurer of the Bankers
Advertising Company. This company is a creditor of the
Shriver for President Committee. The complainant alleges
that the Committee violated the Act by breaching an oral
contract when it failed to liquidate a debt incurred during
the 1976 Presidential primary campaign as promised, by failing
to file reports with the Commission of its outstanding debts,
and by terminating the Committee while it still has debts
outstanding.

As to the breach of contract, there is no reason to believe that any statute within the jurisdiction of the Commission has been violated. The Commission is concerned with questions of extension of credit to candidates and political committees and settlement of corporate debts. 11 C.F.R. § 114.10. The focus of these concerns is to prohibit corporations from forgiving debts owed by candidates or political committees for an amount less than the initial extension of credit unless certain conditions are met which evidence that forgiveness of the debt is not a contribution. The concerns of the Commission regarding debt settlements are inopposite of those of the complainant. There is nothing in the Act or the Regulations which grants the Commission jurisdiction to enforce payment by political committees of debts owed creditors in the fact situation presented. The complainant must look to state law for redress.

The other allegations in the complaint are within the Commission's jurisdiction. The complainant alleges that the Committee violated various reporting provisions of the Act by not reporting its debts and by terminating the committee while still having debts outstanding. A review of the Shriver for President Committee reports shows that the last report filed by the Shriver for President Committee was the July 1978 quarterly. The July 1978 quarterly report did not list any of the debts incurred by the Committee. In fact, the last reporting of the Committee debts was in August, 1976. 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(12) requires that each report filed with the Commission disclose the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by or to the committee until such debts and obligations are extinguished. The failure of the Committee to report its debts since 1976 is an apparent violation of the Act.

A review of the reports does not evidence that the Committee has terminated, but that the Committee has simply not filed reports since July, 1978. By not filing required reports since the July, 1978, quarterly, the Committee apparently violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that the Shriver for President Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(12) by failing to report the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by the Committee.

2. Find reason to believe that the Shriver for President Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) by failing to file reports since the July, 1978, quarterly.
3. Send to respondent the letter of notification.
