

On January 2, 1979, the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred to the Office of General Counsel, the National Women's Political Caucus Campaign Support Committee ("the Committee") in connection with its violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b.

FACTUAL BASIS AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

On January 5, 1978, the Committee accepted a contribution in the amount of \$1,250 from the California Housing Council ("the Council"). On January 30, 1979, RAD sent the Committee a surface violation letter advising it that the subject contribution should be refunded if it was in fact a corporate contribution.

Subsequent to receipt of the Commission's notification, the Committee contacted the Council to ascertain whether its contribution was legally acceptable under the Act. The Committee then advised RAD, via telephone that the Council was a political action committee registered with the State of California and that it's treasury did contain corporate funds.

A review of the materials sent to the Committee by the Council (included in the RAD referral) indicates that the California Housing Council is a corporation, not a political action committee. Therefore, the Council has violated the provisions of § 441b by contributing corporate funds to the Committee and the Committee has violated § 441b by accepting and retaining the contribution.

On March 12, 1979, the Commission was advised by Jane McMichael, Executive Director of the Committee, that it had obtained a loan which it used to refund the \$1,250 contribution to the Council.

Based on the foregoing analysis, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that the California Housing Council, Inc., may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b and closed its file in this matter.

On January 5, 1978, the Committee accepted a contribution in the amount of \$1,250 from the California Housing Council ("the Council"). On January 30, 1979, RAD sent the Committee a surface violation letter advising it that the subject contribution should be refunded if it was in fact a corporate contribution.

Subsequent to receipt of the Commission's notification, the Committee contacted the Council to ascertain whether its contribution was legally acceptable under the Act. The Committee then advised RAD, via telephone, that the Council was a political action committee registered with the State of California and that its treasury did contain corporate funds. A review of the materials sent to the Committee by

the Council (included in the RAD referral) indicates that the California Housing Council is a corporation, not a political action committee. Therefore, the Council has violated the provisions of § 441b by contributing corporate funds to the committee and the Committee has violated § 441b by accepting and retaining the contribution.

On March 12, 1979, the Executive Director of the Committee notified the Commission that it had confirmed that the funds from the Council were in fact corporate and that it had taken immediate steps to refund it by obtaining a loan.

In light of the fact that the subject contribution was made over two years ago, was refunded promptly after it was determined to be corporate and since there was legitimate confusion as to whether the contribution was corporate, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that the Council and the Committee have violated § 441b and close the file.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that the National Women's Political Caucus Campaign Support Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. §441b and close the file.
2. Find reason to believe that the California Housing Council may have violated 2 U.S.C. §441b and close the file.
3. Send attached notification letters.

The contribution should be reported immediately and reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If the identification of the contributor is incomplete or incorrect on the original report, you may do so by amending your original report.


