GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND

On May 30, 1980, the Commission found reason to believe that the Oregon Optometric Public Affairs Council (the "OOPAC") violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 by failing to register and report as a political committee. The OOPAC subsequently submitted a statement of organization and its reports of receipts and disbursements from 1978 to the present on June 3, 1980.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

Upon being notified by the Commission, the OOPAC submitted the forms required by 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434. The report reveals that the OOPAC expended and aggregate of \$1,300 in connection with federal elections in 1978 and \$100, in 1979. The OOPAC also submitted a termination report.

On June 9, 1980, Dr. Claude Brist, treasurer of the OOPAC, telephoned to question whether his submissions were complete. The Office of General Counsel referred Dr. Brist to a reports analyst who informed him of the minor necessary corrections. On June 30, 1980, Dr. Brist submitted the additional information.

RAD notified the Oregon PAC of its registration and reporting responsibilities on December 21, 1979. RAD sent a second notice on February 8, 1980. On February 12, 1980, the treasurer of the Oregon PAC telephoned RAD to state that the committee would register and file the appropriate reports. The treasurer further added that the committee had not responded because the committee had moved to a new office and he was recently elected as treasurer. However, to date, the Oregon PAC has failed to submit the required forms.

In that the aggregate of the contributions exceeds \$1,000 within a calendar year, the Oregon PAC is required to file a statement of organization and to report its receipts and disbursements pursuant to sections 433 and 434. The Office of General Counsel therefore recommends a finding of reason to believe that the Oregon Optometric Public Affairs Council violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 by failing to register and report as a political committee. Accordingly, the Office recommends that the Commission approve the attached letter and notification of a reason to believe finding.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe that the Oregon Optometric Public Affairs Council violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 by failing to register and report as a political committee.

Dear Treasurer:

This letter is to inform you that as of this date, the Commission has not received your response to our letter dated December 21, 1979. Our letter notified you that a review of reports filed with the Commission indicates that your organization may have made contributions which total in excess of \$1,000 during the calendar year.

The Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act) defines "political committee" as any organization or other group of persons which receives contributions or makes expenditures (which includes contributions to Federal candidates and committees supporting Federal candidates) aggregating in excess of \$1,000 during a calendar year. It would appear that your organization may qualify as a "political committee" subject to registration, reporting, and contribution limitation requirements of the Act.

If you agree that your organization is a political committee, please submit a Statement of Organization on FEC Form 1, in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 433. In addition, your committee will be required to file disclosure reports in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434 on FEC Form 3.

If you agree that your organization has made contributions or expenditures which qualify you as a political committee, but you do not wish to be considered as a political committee, you must request refund(s) from the candidate(s) and/or political committee(s) to which you have contributed. As an alternative, political committees to which you made contributions may transfer all or part of the contributions to accounts which are not used to influence Federal elections. Refunds or transfers must be made in such amounts that the total remaining contributions made by you do not exceed \$1,000 during a calendar year.


