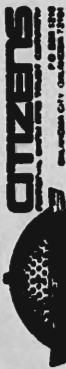



CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. Reason to believe was found that the Oklahoma Medical PAC and its treasurer, Glo Henley, ("Respondent") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A) and 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing to file its Quarterly, Pre-General, Post General, Year End and Mid-Year reports in a timely manner.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondent, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondent, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this Agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent Oklahoma Medical PAC is a political committee as defined by 2 U.S.C. § 431(4). Glo Henley is the registered treasurer of Oklahoma Medical PAC.

2. The 1982 April Quarterly Report which was due on April 15, 1982, was not filed by Respondent until April 18, 1983.

3. The 1982 July Quarterly Report which was due July 15, 1982, was not filed by Respondent until July 28, 1982.

4. The 1982 12 Day Pre-General Election Report which was due October 21, 1982, was not filed by Respondent until March 22, 1983.

5. The 1982 30 Day Post-General Election Report which was due on December 2, 1982, was not filed by Respondent until March 22, 1983.

6. The 1982 Year End Report which was due January 31, 1983, was not filed by Respondent until February 3, 1983.

7. The 1983 Mid Year Report which was due July 31, 1983, was not filed by Respondent until December 16, 1983.

V. Respondent failed to file its 1982 April Quarterly Report, 1982 July Quarterly Report, 1982 Pre-General Election Report, 1982 Post General Election Report, 1982 Year End Report and 1983 Mid-Year Report in a timely manner in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A).

VI. Respondent will pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondent agrees that it shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

The attached agreement contains no changes from the agreement approved by the Commission and a check for the civil penalty approved by the Commission has been received.



On September 12, 1983, the Commission determined that the Oklahoma Medical PAC and Glo Henley, treasurer, ("Respondent") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A) for failing to file its Quarterly, Pre-General, Post General and Year End Reports in a timely manner. On October 28, 1983, the Commission determined that the Respondent violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) for failing to file the mid-year report. In both instances, the Respondent was properly notified.

On December 16, 1983, the Respondent filed its mid-year report with the Commission. Respondent has also requested pre-probable cause conciliation in an effort to settle this matter (Attachment I). In her letter, Glo Henley conceded her neglect in filing the reports in a timely manner.

The Office of General Counsel recommends the Commission accept the offer of the Respondent and enter into pre-probable cause conciliation.

Respondent has habitually filed its reports late. The 1982 Pre-General Report was filed five months late and the 1982 Post-General Report was filed four months late. The 1983 Mid Year Report was filed over four months late. Based on these facts the Office of General Counsel recommends a civil penalty of \$250.

On September 12, 1983, the Commission determined that there was reason to believe the Oklahoma Medical PAC and Glo Henley, Treasurer ("respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A) for the failure to file the Quarterly, Pre-General, Post General and Year End reports in a timely manner. Also, on October 28, 1983, the Commission determined that there was reason to believe that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) for the failure to file the mid-year report.

On December 13, 1983, General Counsel staff telephoned the treasurer, Glo Henley, to inquire as to the status of this matter. Ms. Henley indicated she had no knowledge of the Commission's two RTB findings since she and another individual occassionally shared the responsibility of retrieving mail from the committee's post office box. She did indicate an interest in wanting to resolve the matter, however. On December 16, 1983, the Oklahoma Medical PAC filed its mid-year report with the Commission (Attachment). Simultaneously, the respondent requested that Pre-probable cause conciliation be entered into in an effort to resolve this matter.







In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against you and the committee, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if you and the committee so desire. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you and the committee intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

All unauthorized political committees must file the First Quarterly Report, unless they are filing on a monthly basis. Monthly filers should refer to "Monthly Filing Schedule for 1982" (see below) for information on monthly filing requirements.

Committees must file the First Quarterly Report disclosing all reportable transactions from the later of:

- The date of registration, if this is the committee's first report; or
- The date of the close of books of the last report filed.

The First Quarterly Report must disclose all financial activity of the committee not previously disclosed through March 31, 1982, and must be filed regardless of the amount of financial activity involved during the reporting period.

DATE DUE

The First Quarterly Report may be hand-delivered on or before the close of business April 15, 1982. Reports mailed first-class must be received no later than the close of business April 15. Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight April 15.

WHAT FORM TO USE

All unauthorized political committees should use FEC Form 3X with appropriate schedules for filing the report. If an unauthorized committee has qualified as a multicandidate committee during this reporting period, it should check the appropriate box on Page One of FEC Form 3X. (See FEC Regulations at 100.5(e)(3) for definition of a multicandidate committee.)

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the reverse side of the Summary Page of the reporting form for details on where to file their reports.

MONTHLY FILING SCHEDULE FOR 1982

Unauthorized committees reporting on a monthly filing schedule must file their monthly report on April 20, covering March 1 through March 31, 1982. This report is filed in lieu of the First Quarterly Report. These committees will subsequently follow the regular monthly reporting schedule. 11 CFR 104.5(c)(3).

NOTIFICATION OF FILING FREQUENCY CHANGE

Unauthorized committees that wish to change their reporting schedule during 1982 must notify the Commission of their intention by letter submitted with the next report due. A committee may not change its filing frequency more than once during 1982. 11 CFR 104.5(c).

FAILURE TO FILE REPORTS

Committees should be aware that failure to file required reports may result in compliance proceedings under the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act. According to a revised Commission policy, committees will no longer receive mailgram notification of their failure to file reports. The new policy does not exempt committees from being fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act.

NOTE: Committees must submit legible reports which can be reproduced clearly. Illegible documents will not be accepted as reports, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

WHO MUST FILE

All political committees which are not authorized committees of a candidate for Federal office, must file a Pre-General Election Report of Receipts and Disbursements by October 21, 1982, if the committee has made contributions or expenditures (including independent or coordinated expenditures) in connection with the general election and if such contributions or expenditures have not been previously disclosed.

All committees must file a Post-General Election Report due December 2, 1982, regardless of the total amount of financial activity during the respective reporting period. For committees that filed a Pre-General Election Report, the coverage dates for the Post-General Election Report will be October 14, 1982, through November 22, 1982. For committees which did not file a Pre-General Election Report, the coverage dates for the Post-General Election Report will be either the date of committee registration or the close of books of the last report filed, through November 22, 1982. These reports must disclose all financial activity not previously disclosed.

NOTE: Committees filing monthly reports are required to file the Pre-General and Post-General Reports. In addition, these committees must file a Year-End Report, due January 31, 1983. These reports are required to be filed in lieu of monthly reports due November, December and January.

COMMITTEES NOT REQUIRED TO FILE THE PRE-GENERAL REPORT

- Political committees (other than monthly filers) which will not make contributions or expenditures in connection with the 1982 general election during the period October 1, 1982 (or from the date of committee registration or close of books of last report filed, if after October 1) through October 13, 1982. These committees must, however, file the Post-General Election Report.
- Organizations which do not meet the definition of a "political committee" under the Act (2 U.S.C. §431(4)).

NOTE: Committees not required to file the Pre-General Report may wish to notify the Commission of this fact in writing prior to October 21, 1982, for the public record.

DATE DUE

The Pre-General Election Report must be hand-delivered or received by first class mail at the appropriate filing office no later than close of business October 21, 1982. Reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight October 18, 1982.

The Post-General Election Report must be hand-delivered or received by first class mail at the appropriate filing office no later than close of business on December 2, 1982. Reports sent by certified or registered mail must be postmarked no later than midnight December 2, 1982.

FACTUAL BASIS AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), all political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate are required to file quarterly reports in a calendar year in which a regularly scheduled general election is held. These quarterly reports are to be filed no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter, except that the report for the quarter ending on December 31 of such calendar year is to be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar quarter.

In addition, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) states that a pre-election report shall be filed no later than the 12th day before an election, and 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) states that a post-election report shall be filed no later than the 30th day after the general election. The respondent also violated the Act when it failed to file its Pre-General Report until five (5) months after it was due and its Post General Report until over three (3) months after it was due.

Since the respondent has established a habit of consistently filing late reports, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that the Oklahoma Medical PAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A).



For committees which did not file a Pre-General Election Report, the coverage dates for the Post-General Election Report will be either the date of committee registration or the close of books of the last report filed, through November 22, 1982. All unauthorized political committees required to file must use FEC Form 3X with appropriate schedules contained in this packet. Committees should consult the instructions on the back of each form for detailed information on the contents of the report.

Please peel off the label on the envelope used for this mailing and place it on the front of the reporting form. This will assist the Commission in the identification of the committee filing the report.

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the back of the Summary Page of Form 3X for instructions on where to file their reports.

FAILURE TO FILE REPORTS

Committees should be aware that failure to file required reports may result in compliance proceedings under the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act. According to a revised Commission policy, although political committees that are not authorized by any Federal candidate will no longer receive mailgram notification of their failure to file reports, they nevertheless remain fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act.

Committees must submit legible reports which can be reproduced clearly. Illegible documents will not be accepted as reports, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.
