

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Oklahoma Medical PAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing to file its Year End Report of Receipts and Expenditures in a timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent Oklahoma Medical PAC is a political action committee registered with the Commission.

2. Respondent Glo Henley is the registered treasurer of Oklahoma Medical PAC.

3. Respondents were required to file the 1983 Year End Report of Receipts and Expenditures by January 31, 1984, however, the report was not filed by that date.

V. Respondents' failure to file the 1983 Year End Report in a timely manner violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents agree not to undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

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X. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND

On May 30, 1984, the Commission found reason to believe OMPAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing to file the 1983 Year End Report for the reporting period beginning July 1 and ending December 31, 1983. OMPAC officials had indicated that the report was mailed on January 31, 1984, however, no proof of the mailing was ever provided. In any event, for the report to have been filed in a timely manner it should have been filed by January 31, 1984, rather than mailed on that date.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

OMPAC and Glo Henley had previously been cited by the Commission for failure to file the 1983 Mid-Year Report in a timely manner in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Association, David Bickham, responded to the Commission's reason to believe finding on behalf of OMPAC (Attachment I). In a following letter, and in an effort to conclude this matter as expeditiously as possible, Mr. Bickham formally requested that the Commission enter into Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation with OMPAC (Attachment II).

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RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Enter into conciliation with the Oklahoma Medical PAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer, prior to a finding of probable cause.
2. Approve the attached proposed conciliation agreement.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

This matter was generated as a result of a review of respondent's reports of receipts and disbursements by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD").

The Oklahoma Medical Political Action Committee ("OMPAC") and Glo Henley, as treasurer, failed to file the 1983 Year End Report of Receipts and Disbursements for the reporting period beginning July 1 and ending December 31, 1983, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv). OMPAC was notified that the report was due on January 31, 1984 and a non-filer notice was sent on February 28, 1984.

On March 21, 1984, OMPAC's former treasurer, Glo Henley, was contacted by a RAD analyst who inquired as to the status of the report. Ms. Henley stated that the report had been mailed to the Commission on January 31, 1984 and that if it had not been received, a copy would be sent immediately. As of April 13, 1984, the RAD analyst indicated that the report had not been received.

In a telephone conversation on April 17, 1984, with General Counsel staff regarding a separate matter, Lyle Kelsey, former Executive Director of OMPAC expressed dismay at being informed that the Commission had not received OMPAC's Year End Report.

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Mr. Kelsey indicated that he was aware of the RAD analyst's telephone call to Glo Henley, and, in fact, indicated that he had witnessed Ms. Henley depositing the report in the mail. Nevertheless, General Counsel staff instructed Mr. Kelsey to send the report by registered mail. On April 20, 1984, the report was received at the Commission.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

It appears that OMPAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer, failed to file the Year End Report in a timely manner. An OMPAC official stated that he mailed the report on January 31, 1984, however, he has provided no proof of such mailing. 

WHO MUST FILE

ALL POLITICAL COMMITTEES currently registered with the Commission must file a year-end report by January 31, 1984.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

All financial activity must be disclosed from the last report filed through December 31, 1983. Registered committees which have not previously filed a financial disclosure report should report all financial activity from the date of registration* through December 31, 1983.

FILING DATE

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight January 31, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business January 31, 1984.

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed form for details.

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Furthermore, failure to file in a timely fashion is a serious violation and an offending committee is subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within ten days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form

stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

This matter was generated as a result of a review of respondent's reports of receipts and disbursements by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD").

The Oklahoma Medical Political Action Committee ("OMPAC") and Glo Henley, as treasurer, failed to file the 1983 Year End Report of Receipts and Disbursements for the reporting period beginning July 1 and ending December 31, 1983, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv). OMPAC was notified that the report was due on January 31, 1984 and a non-filer notice was sent on February 28, 1984.

On March 21, 1984, OMPAC's former treasurer, Glo Henley, was contacted by a RAD analyst who inquired as to the status of the report. Ms. Henley stated that the report had been mailed to the Commission on January 31, 1984 and that if it had not been received, a copy would be sent immediately. As of April 13, 1984, the RAD analyst indicated that the report had not been received.

In a telephone conversation on April 17, 1984, with General Counsel staff regarding a separate matter, Lyle Kelsey, former Executive Director of OMPAC expressed dismay at being informed that the Commission had not received OMPAC's Year End Report.

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Mr. Kelsey indicated that he was aware of the RAD analyst's telephone call to Glo Henley, and, in fact, indicated that he had witnessed Ms. Henley depositing the report in the mail. Nevertheless, General Counsel staff instructed Mr. Kelsey to send the report by registered mail. On April 20, 1984, the report was received at the Commission.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

It appears that OMPAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer, failed to file the Year End Report in a timely manner. An OMPAC official stated that he mailed the report on January 31, 1984, however, he has provided no proof of such mailing. In any event, for the report to have been filed in a timely manner it should have been filed by January 31, 1984, rather than mailed on that date. Since the report was not filed in a timely manner, the General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a MUR and find reason to believe OMPAC and Glo Henley, as treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) for failing to file the Year End Report in a timely manner.

JANUARY 31 YEAR-END REPORT NOTICE

WHO MUST FILE

ALL POLITICAL COMMITTEES currently registered with the Commission must file a year-end report by January 31, 1984.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

All financial activity must be disclosed from the last report filed through December 31, 1983. Registered committees which have not previously filed a financial disclosure report should report all financial activity from the date of registration* through December 31, 1983.

FILING DATE

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight January 31, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business January 31, 1984.

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed form for details.

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Furthermore, failure to file in a timely fashion is a serious violation and an offending committee is subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

1984 FILING REQUIREMENTS

See the January 1984 issue of the FEC Record for filing requirements during 1984.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).
