

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

SENSITIVE

I. BACKGROUND

This matter originated from a complaint filed by Mary Monahan on behalf of the Minnesota DFL State Party, alleging that the Trueman for Congress Committee ("the Trueman Committee") and LeRoy A. Kreitlow, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2) by failing to report in-kind contributions received from the Fund for a Conservative Majority ("FCM") during the period August 17, 1983 through August 1, 1984.

On the basis of information in the complaint and on the public record, the Commission, on October 31, 1984, found reason to believe that the Trueman Committee and LeRoy A. Kreitlow, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2).

In reply to the notice of the Commission's finding, LeRoy Kreitlow sent a letter generally admitting violations of the Act and requesting to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the Commission. On December 18, 1984, the Commission, at the respondents' request, agreed to enter into conciliation with the respondents. Notice of the Commission's determination and a proposed conciliation agreement were sent to the respondents on January 2, 1985.

On February 21, 1985, the Office of the General Counsel received a letter from Patrick A. Trueman, responding on behalf of his principal campaign committee and its treasurer. The letter calls the Commission's attention to the inaccuracies of the Trueman Committee's response to the Commission's notice of its finding of reason to believe, explains the circumstances therefore, and requests that the Commission find that there were no violations on behalf of the Trueman Committee and its treasurer. See Attached response at 1-14. In addition, the General Counsel's Office received a letter dated March 8, 1985, from FCM. The letter explains the circumstances which contributed to the Trueman Committee's failure to report in-kind contributions. See Attachments at 15-16.

On the basis of new information brought forth in these responses the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action and close the file.

II. FACTUAL BASIS AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

A. The Facts

At issue in this case is the disclosure of in-kind contributions to the Trueman Committee from FCM valued at \$1,089.84. The in-kind contributions were reportedly made between the period August 17, 1983 through August 1, 1984. FCM disclosed the in-kind contributions in its reports to the Commission. The reports of the Trueman Committee allegedly failed to show corresponding receipts for the in-kind

contributions that included such things as the value of FCM's political director's time, postage, delivery, and meetings held at the Capitol Hill Club.

On the basis of information in the complaint and on the public record, the Commission found reason to believe that the Trueman Committee and LeRoy A. Kreitlow violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2) by failing to report in-kind contributions from FCM.

In a letter sent to the Commission on November 15, 1984, over the signature of LeRoy Kreitlow, the respondents generally admitted their failure to report the in-kind contributions and requested to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation. The letter attributed the respondents' failure to report the in-kind contributions to two factors: 1) FCM's failure to inform the Trueman Committee of any in-kind contributions made during the campaign, after having been instructed to do so, and 2) a lack of communication within the Trueman Committee. With regard to the second factor, the letter stated:

Since there were different people who prepared the reports for the Federal Election Commission than who worked with the Fund for a Conservative Majority, these in-kind contributions were not known by those who prepared the reports. When no exact figures of these contributions were sent to us, they were inadvertently forgotten.

Mr. Patrick Trueman now calls the Commission's attention to the inaccuracies of the above statement. According to Mr.

Trueman, the above statement was prepared from information provided to Mr. Kreitlow by a young political intern on the campaign. Mr. Trueman states that the intern was believed to have been receiving help from a lawyer, however, Mr. Trueman has learned that most of the preparation was in fact done by the intern.

Now having reviewed the facts of the matter and after having interviewed the appropriate parties both on his campaign and with FCM, Mr. Trueman concludes that "the problem was primarily the fault of FCM." See Response at 3.

Mr. Trueman asserts that the Trueman Committee made reasonable efforts to seek information from FCM on the amount and purpose of in-kind contributions and that FCM failed to provide such information on numerous occasions. 1/ Moreover, Mr. Trueman states that FCM indicated to him that FCM's policy is to notify candidates of all in-kind contributions, but that for reasons unknown, his campaign did not receive many notices. See Response at 3.

According to Mr. Trueman, FCM and the Trueman Committee worked together on certain matters during the campaign. In addition, FCM made in-kind contributions on its own without

1/ Mr. Trueman cites as an example the fact that after the complaint was filed the Trueman Committee requested FCM to prepare a list of all in-kind contributions made to the Committee. FCM supplied a list which, the Trueman Committee was told, represented a complete list of all contributions made to the Trueman Committee. In a phone conversation with a FCM representative on January 30, 1985, Mr. Trueman was notified for the first time of additional in-kind contributions made to the Trueman Committee in February, August and September of 1984. The Trueman Committee has filed amended reports to disclose these additional in-kind contributions.

working directly with the Trueman Committee. Although not specifically stated, Mr. Trueman's response appears to suggest that perhaps some of the unreported in-kind contributions were made without the Trueman Committee's knowledge.

Mr. Trueman calls the Commission's attention to the fact that as soon as the Trueman Committee was made aware of the omissions in reporting in-kind contributions received from FCM, the Trueman Committee immediately took steps to correct the problem and to notify the Commission. Mr. Trueman notes that at one point the Committee had reported the same contributions twice. According to Mr. Trueman, the duplication problem resulted from the fact that the Trueman Committee reported the value of the in-kind contributions in the same manner as FCM had reported it to them -- in a lump sum amount. FCM's reports, however, disclosed several small contributions totalling this amount. When the Trueman Committee was notified of the instant complaint which alleges that the smaller contribution amounts had not been disclosed, the Trueman Committee immediately filed a report disclosing the smaller contribution amounts. After an in-depth review of the contributions, Mr. Trueman realized the duplication problem and amended the Committee's reports. Of the \$1,089.84 in-kind contributions that the complainant alleged had not been disclosed, Mr. Trueman's review revealed that \$232.23 had previously been disclosed in the Trueman Committee's 1983 Year End Report as part of the total value (\$415.76) of in-kind

contributions reported to have been received from FCM during the period 8/18/83 through 12/31/83.

In its letter to the Commission, dated March 8, 1985, FCM confirms the information provided by Mr. Trueman. FCM attributes the omissions in the Trueman Committee's reports to the fact that FCM failed to communicate information regarding in-kind contributions to the Trueman Committee. FCM states that the oversight was due to a change in personnel. The letter further states that when the Treasurer of FCM learned of the problem, he immediately instituted corrective measures and procedures designed to assure that contributions in-kind are reported to the relevant committees in a timely manner.

B. Application of the Law to the Facts

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2), the treasurer of a political committee is required to disclose the value of in-kind contributions received.

At issue in this case is the Trueman committee's failure to report the receipt of in-kind contributions from FCM valued at \$1,089.84. Information obtained in this matter demonstrates that of this amount \$232.23 had been disclosed previously, but that the Trueman Committee failed to report a remaining \$851.61 in in-kind contributions from FCM.

With respect to this matter it is the recommendation of this Office that no further action be taken by the Commission. Upon being notified of the omissions in its reports, the Trueman

Committee took affirmative steps to obtain information from FCM and to correct its reports by filing amendments with the Commission. Moreover, the Trueman Committee has explained the circumstances of its failure to disclose the receipt of in-kind contributions, including the fact that during the campaign it made efforts to obtain the information from FCM but that FCM failed to provide such information in a timely manner and in accordance with its own internal policies. This explanation has been verified by FCM in a letter to the Commission.

In view of the foregoing mitigating circumstances and in consideration of the fact that the Commission has made a reason to believe finding with respect to this issue, thereby placing the Trueman Committee on notice of the violation, it is the recommendation of this Office that the Commission take no further action against the Trueman Committee and LeRoy A. Kreitlow, as treasurer, and close the file.



Dear Ms. Elliott:

I was a candidate for United States Congress in 1984. A complaint was filed against my election committee and my Treasurer, LeRoy Kreitlow. Mr. Kreitlow, in a letter dated November 14, 1984, provided an answer to the complaint.

I was not involved in this matter prior to the day of election, but after the election I decided to look into it myself and I discovered that Mr. Kreitlow's response was inappropriate and inaccurate. I therefore decided to contact the Federal Election Commission on my own to see if I could provide an accurate response. I contacted the Commission by phone before receiving your proposed conciliation agreement.

I am now representing my election committee and Mr. Kreitlow at this time. On behalf of my committee and Mr. Kreitlow, I wish to withdraw the answer provided by Mr. Kreitlow. Mr. Kreitlow's response was prepared from information given to him by Roger Christiansen, who was a young political intern on my campaign and should not have been handling this matter before the Commission. I have recently inquired from my campaign manager as to why Mr. Christiansen was assigned to this matter. My campaign manager informs me that he was under the impression that Mr. Christiansen was receiving help from a lawyer. It appears, however, that Mr. Christiansen received only preliminary help from a lawyer but did most of the preparation of Mr. Kreitlow's response on his own. The complaint was filed late in the campaign and this undoubtedly contributed to the fact that my committee improperly handled the answer.

I would like to call to your attention the inaccuracies contained in paragraph III of Mr. Kreitlow's response to the Commission. There it is stated that contributions from the Fund for a Conservative Majority (hereinafter FCM) were "inadvertently forgotten." This is not true. The paragraph also inaccurately points out that a problem arose in our office because different people prepared reports for the Federal Election Commission than those who work with the Fund for a Conservative Majority.

After a thorough review of all the relevant facts on this matter, the contributions involved and after interviewing the appropriate parties both on my campaign and

with The Fund for Conservative Majority, I am unable to state exactly how the difficulty arose. I believe, however, that the problem was primarily the fault of FCM.

During the campaign the Trueman for Congress Committee made reasonable efforts to seek information from FCM on the amount and purpose of in kind contributions. FCM failed to provide such information on numerous occasions. In fact, FCM notified me for the first time of five additional in kind contributions made during the campaign (on 2/1/84, 8/1/84, 9/5/84, 9/17/84 and 9/21/84) in a phone conversation I had with a representative of their group on January 30 of this year. Our committee was unaware of activities associated with these contributions until January 30, 1985. I want to stress that, at the time it was notified of this complaint by the Commission, my committee requested of FCM a list of all contributions made by FCM to Trueman for Congress at anytime. Soon after that request FCM supplied a list which we were told represented a complete list of all contributions made to Trueman for Congress. The fact that the list was incomplete supports the contention of the Trueman for Congress Committee that the unreporting problem is primarily the fault of FCM. FCM indicated to me that their policy is to notify candidates of all in kind contributions as they are made but, for reasons unknown, my campaign did not receive many notices.

I am unable to state categorically that my committee was unaware during the campaign of any activities of FCM which were required to be reported as "in kind" contributions. FCM and the Trueman for Congress Committee worked together on certain matters during the campaign. However, my committee exerted its best efforts to learn the nature and amount of all FCM in kind contributions and report them in a timely manner. FCM clearly made many contributions on its own and without working directly with our committee. These contributions were perhaps an ongoing service of FCM to help my committee throughout the campaign.

As soon as I was made aware of omissions in reporting in kind contributions from FCM our committee immediately took steps to correct the problem and notify the FEC.

I call your attention to our Federal Election Commission report for the period covering 8/23/84 through 9/30/84, which I have enclosed. This report details a contribution of \$193.53 for the date of 8/17/84 and represents the amount paid for a portion of a breakfast for political action committees held on that date at the Capitol Hill Club. We were notified of that amount during the period 8/23/84 through 9/30/84 and therefore, I believe it is correctly reported on this report. The other several contributions listed on the same page represent my committee's effort to correct the unreporting problem. I believe some of the contributions listed actually duplicate previous reports. In fact, the first contribution listed, dated 8/17/83 in the amount of \$8.71 and the second contribution dated 9/22/83 in the amount of \$20.30 and the fifth contribution



listed inaccurately dated 9/30/84 (the correct year is '83) in the amount of \$203.20 were included in our report covering the period of 8/18/83 through 12/31/83 (this is the contribution of \$415.76). Other contributions on that page were not reported to us by the Fund for a Conservative Majority until just before we reported them. I am enclosing an amended FEC report for the period of 8/23/84 through 9/30/84 correcting the duplication problem and reporting in kind contributions which we have been made aware of on January 30 of this year (mentioned above). I also call your attention to the enclosed copy of our Federal Election Commission Report for the period of 8/18/83 through 12/31/83. On that report we show in kind contributions in the amount of \$415.76. I believe this contribution represents payment for activities associated with a Capitol Hill Club breakfast for the Trueman for Congress campaign sponsored by the Fund for a Conservative Majority. Perhaps this amount should be broken down into several smaller contributions, but this is the way the contribution was reported to us by the Fund for a Conservative Majority. FCM has reported to me on January 30, 1985 that the \$415.76 represents the following contributions: \$12.48 on 5/25/83; \$31.15 on 6/8/83; \$118.94 on 7/20/83; \$4.34 on 7/20/83; \$16.64 on 7/27/83; \$8.71 on 8/17/83; \$20.30 on 9/22/83; \$203.22 on 9/30/83. These activities were associated with a PAC breakfast held at the Capitol Hill Club for my committee.

I request that the Federal Election Commission find that there were no violations on behalf of the Trueman for Congress Committee. If I can provide any further information, I hope you won't hesitate to contact me at one of the above numbers.

I was a candidate for United States Congress in 1984. A complaint was filed against my election committee and my Treasurer, LeRoy Kreitlow. Mr. Kreitlow, in a letter dated November 14, 1984, provided an answer to the complaint.

I was not involved in this matter prior to the day of election, but after the election I decided to look into it myself and I discovered that Mr. Kreitlow's response was inappropriate and inaccurate. I therefore decided to contact the Federal Election Commission on my own to see if I could provide an accurate response. I contacted the Commission by phone before receiving your proposed conciliation agreement.

I am now representing my election committee and Mr. Kreitlow at this time. On behalf of my committee and Mr. Kreitlow, I wish to withdraw the answer provided by Mr. Kreitlow. Mr. Kreitlow's response was prepared from information given to him by Roger Christiansen, who was a young political intern on my campaign and should not have been handling this matter before the Commission. I have recently inquired from my campaign manager as to why Mr. Christiansen was assigned to this matter. My campaign manager informs me that he was under the impression that Mr. Christiansen was receiving help from a lawyer. It appears, however, that Mr. Christiansen received only preliminary help from a lawyer but did most of the preparation of Mr. Kreitlow's response on his own. The complaint was filed late in the campaign and this undoubtedly contributed to the fact that my committee improperly handled the answer.

I would like to call to your attention the inaccuracies contained in paragraph III of Mr. Kreitlow's response to the Commission. There it is stated that contributions from the Fund for a Conservative Majority (hereinafter FCM) were "inadvertently forgotten." This is not true. The paragraph also inaccurately points out that a problem arose in our office because different people prepared reports for the Federal Election Commission than those who work with the Fund for a Conservative Majority.

After a thorough review of all the relevant facts on this matter, the contributions involved and after interviewing the appropriate parties both on my campaign and

with The Fund for Conservative Majority, I am unable to state exactly how the difficulty arose. I believe, however, that the problem was primarily the fault of FCM.

During the campaign the Trueman for Congress Committee made reasonable efforts to seek information from FCM on the amount and purpose of in kind contributions. FCM failed to provide such information on numerous occasions. In fact, FCM notified me for the first time of five additional in kind contributions made during the campaign (on 2/1/84, 8/1/84, 9/5/84, 9/17/84 and 9/21/84) in a phone conversation I had with a representative of their group on January 30 of this year. Our committee was unaware of activities associated with these contributions until January 30, 1985. I want to stress that, at the time it was notified of this complaint by the Commission, my committee requested of FCM a list of all contributions made by FCM to Trueman for Congress at anytime. Soon after that request FCM supplied a list which we were told represented a complete list of all contributions made to Trueman for Congress. The fact that the list was incomplete supports the contention of the Trueman for Congress Committee that the unreporting problem is primarily the fault of FCM. FCM indicated to me that their policy is to notify candidates of all in kind contributions as they are made but, for reasons unknown, my campaign did not receive many notices.

I am unable to state categorically that my committee was unaware during the campaign of any activities of FCM which were required to be reported as "in kind" contributions. FCM and the Trueman for Congress Committee worked together on certain matters during the campaign. However, my committee exerted its best efforts to learn the nature and amount of all FCM in kind contributions and report them in a timely manner. FCM clearly made many contributions on its own and without working directly with our committee. These contributions were perhaps an ongoing service of FCM to help my committee throughout the campaign.

As soon as I was made aware of omissions in reporting in kind contributions from FCM our committee immediately took steps to correct the problem and notify the FEC.

I call your attention to our Federal Election Commission report for the period covering 8/23/84 through 9/30/84, which I have enclosed. This report details a contribution of \$193.53 for the date of 8/17/84 and represents the amount paid for a portion of a breakfast for political action committees held on that date at the Capitol Hill Club. We were notified of that amount during the period 8/23/84 through 9/30/84 and therefore, I believe it is correctly reported on this report. The other several contributions listed on the same page represent my committee's effort to correct the unreporting problem. I believe some of the contributions listed actually duplicate previous reports. In fact, the first contribution listed, dated 8/17/83 in the amount of \$8.71 and the second contribution dated 9/22/83 in the amount of \$20.30 and the fifth contribution



listed inaccurately dated 9/30/84 (the correct year is '83) in the amount of \$203.20 were included in our report covering the period of 8/18/83 through 12/31/83 (this is the contribution of \$415.76). Other contributions on that page were not reported to us by the Fund for a Conservative Majority until just before we reported them. I am enclosing an amended FEC report for the period of 8/23/84 through 9/30/84 correcting the duplication problem and reporting in kind contributions which we have been made aware of on January 30 of this year (mentioned above). I also call your attention to the enclosed copy of our Federal Election Commission Report for the period of 8/18/83 through 12/31/83. On that report we show in kind contributions in the amount of \$415.76. I believe this contribution represents payment for activities associated with a Capitol Hill Club breakfast for the Trueman for Congress campaign sponsored by the Fund for a Conservative Majority. Perhaps this amount should be broken down into several smaller contributions, but this is the way the contribution was reported to us by the Fund for a Conservative Majority. FCM has reported to me on January 30, 1985 that the \$415.76 represents the following contributions: \$12.48 on 5/25/83; \$31.15 on 6/8/83; \$118.94 on 7/20/83; \$4.34 on 7/20/83; \$16.64 on 7/27/83; \$8.71 on 8/17/83; \$20.30 on 9/22/83; \$203.22 on 9/30/83. These activities were associated with a PAC breakfast held at the Capitol Hill Club for my committee.

I request that the Federal Election Commission find that there were no violations on behalf of the Trueman for Congress Committee. If I can provide any further information, I hope you won't hesitate to contact me at one of the above numbers.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

This matter originated with a complaint filed by Mary Monahan on behalf of the Minnesota DFL State Party, alleging that the Trueman For Congress Committee ("Trueman Committee") and Mr. Leroy A. Kreitlow, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2) by failing to report in-kind contributions received from the Fund For A Conservative Majority ("FCM") during the period of August 17, 1983 through August 1, 1984. On the basis of information in the complaint and information appearing on the public record, the Commission, on October 31, 1984, found reason to believe that the Trueman Committee and its treasurer, Mr. Kreitlow, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2).

Responses to the original complaint and to the Commission's finding were received on November 2 and 15, respectively. See attachments. The responses urge the Commission to find no probable cause to believe a violation occurred or, in the alternative, request to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the Commission.

II. LEGAL ANALYSIS

The response of the Trueman Committee generally admits a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.13(a)(1) and (2). However, the respondents request that the Commission take no further action in view of the circumstances surrounding the violation.

The response attributes a lack of communication between FCM and the Trueman Committee as the reason for its delinquent reporting of in-kind contributions totalling \$1,089.84. The response states that the Trueman Committee had instructed FCM to inform them of the amounts of any in-kind contributions made during the campaign. Despite this request, the response states that FCM failed to inform the Trueman Committee of in-kind contributions.

In addition, the response acknowledges that a lack of communication within the Trueman Committee may have contributed to their oversight in reporting in-kind contributions received from FCM. Apparently those individuals who worked with FCM failed to pass on information to the individuals who were responsible for preparing the reports of the Trueman Committee.

Finally, the response notes that the Trueman Committee took immediate steps to correct the violation once it learned through the complaint that it had failed to report in-kind contributions from FCM. The Trueman Committee subsequently disclosed the in-kind contributions in its third quarterly report for 1984.

It is the view of this Office that a lack of communication is not a sufficient defense, particularly in light of the period of time that in-kind contributions went unreported. Accordingly, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the respondents in this matter.

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AND CIVIL PENALTY
