
Dear Mr. Karlsen:

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee, is a political committee registered with the Commission.

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2. Respondent, Thomas F. Karlsen, is the treasurer of the Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee.

3. Respondents were required to file the 1983 Mid-Year Report by July 31, 1983. The report was filed on August 23, 1983.

4. Respondents were required to file the 1983 Year-End Report by January 31, 1984. The report was filed on February 27, 1984.

5. Respondents were required to file the 1984 Post-General Election Report by December 6, 1984. The report was filed on January 11, 1985.

V. Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv) by failing to file timely the 1983 Mid-Year Report, the 1983 Year-End Report, and the 1984 Post-General Election Report.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents agree that they shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

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IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.





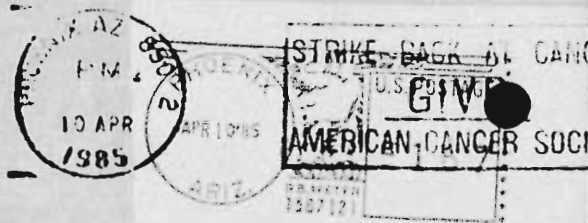

Dear Mr. Karlsen:

On March 28, 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe the Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within ten days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form

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

stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee ("Committee") and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer, failed to file three reports in a timely manner during the 1983-1984 election cycle.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The Committee failed to file three reports in a timely manner during the 1983-1984 election cycle.\* / The reports were filed between 23 and 36 calendar days late. The reports at issue are the following:

On May 16, 1984, a chronic late filing notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1983 Mid-Year and 1983 Year-End Reports in a timely manner. The notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result

in an enforcement action. Subsequent to its receipt of the notice the Committee failed to file the 1984 Post-General Election Report in a timely manner.

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii), a political committee is required to file a post-general election report no later than the 30th day after the general election which shall be complete as of the 20th day after such general election. In addition, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) requires a political committee, in other than an election year, to file a report covering the period beginning January 1 and ending June 30, no later than July 31, and a report covering the period beginning July 1 and ending December 31 no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

The Committee was required to file its 1983 Mid-Year Report, 1983 Year-End Report, and 1984 Post-General Election Report by July 31, 1983, January 31, 1984, and December 6, 1984, respectively. The 1984 Post-General Election Report was filed late despite the Committee's receipt of a chronic late filing notice. In view of the repeated failure of the Committee to file the above reports timely, it is the recommendation of this office that the Commission find reason to believe the Committee and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv).

**GENERATION OF MATTER**

On February 13, 1985, the Reports Analysis Division referred the Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee ("Committee") to the Office of the General Counsel (Attachment 1).

**FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS**

(a) The Facts

The Committee failed to file three reports in a timely manner during the 1983-1984 election cycle.\*/ The reports were filed between 23 and 36 calendar days late. The reports at issue are the following:

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On May 16, 1984, a chronic late filing notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1983 Mid-Year and 1983 Year-End Reports in a timely manner. The notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in an enforcement action. Subsequent to its receipt of the notice the Committee failed to file the 1984 Post-General Election Report in a timely manner.

(b) The applicable law

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii), a political committee is required to file a post-general election report no later than the 30th day after the general election which shall be complete as of the 20th day after such general election. In addition, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) requires a political committee, in other than an election year, to file a report covering the period beginning January 1 and ending June 30, no later than July 31, and a report covering the period beginning July 1 and ending December 31 no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

(c) Application of the law to the facts

The Committee was required to file its 1983 Mid-Year Report, 1983 Year-End Report, and 1984 Post-General Election Report by July 31, 1983, January 31, 1984, and December 6, 1984, respectively. The 1984 Post-General Election Report was filed late despite the Committee's receipt of a chronic late filing notice. In view of the repeated failure of the Committee to file the above reports timely, it is the recommendation of this office

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that the Commission open a Matter Under Review and find reason to believe the Committee and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv).



The Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee ("the Committee") failed to file three (3) Reports of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner for the 1983-84 election cycle (see Chart on Page 2). The reports were filed between 23 and 36 calendar days late.

On May 16, 1984 a Chronic Late Filing Notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1983 Mid-Year and 1983 Year-End Reports in a timely manner (Attachment 6). The Notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in legal enforcement action. Subsequent to the sending of the warning notice, the Committee failed to timely file the 1984 30 Day Post-General Report. The aforementioned report was filed on January 11, 1985.



The Arizona Leadership for America Search Committee ("Committee") and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer, failed to file three reports in a timely manner during the 1983-1984 election cycle.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The Committee failed to file three reports in a timely manner during the 1983-1984 election cycle.\*/ The reports were filed between 23 and 36 calendar days late. The reports at issue are the following:

On May 16, 1984, a chronic late filing notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1983 Mid-Year and 1983 Year-End Reports in a timely manner. The notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result

in an enforcement action. Subsequent to its receipt of the notice the Committee failed to file the 1984 Post-General Election Report in a timely manner.

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii), a political committee is required to file a post-general election report no later than the 30th day after the general election which shall be complete as of the 20th day after such general election. In addition, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) requires a political committee, in other than an election year, to file a report covering the period beginning January 1 and ending June 30, no later than July 31, and a report covering the period beginning July 1 and ending December 31 no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

The Committee was required to file its 1983 Mid-Year Report, 1983 Year-End Report, and 1984 Post-General Election Report by July 31, 1983, January 31, 1984, and December 6, 1984, respectively. The 1984 Post-General Election Report was filed late despite the Committee's receipt of a chronic late filing notice. In view of the repeated failure of the Committee to file the above reports timely, it is the recommendation of this office that the Commission find reason to believe the Committee and Thomas F. Karlsen, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) and (iv).
