Instructions for Form 2

For additional information see Part 100 through Part 103 of
Federal Election Commission Regulations

A. WHO MUST USE FORM 2

Each individual who becomes a candidate for nomination or election to Federal office must file this form, or a letter containing this same information. An individual becomes a candidate for Federal Office whenever any of the following events occur:

(1) The individual has taken the action necessary, under relevant State law, to qualify in a primary, runoff, special or general election; or

(2) The individual has received contributions or made expenditures, or has given consent for any other person to receive contributions or make expenditures, with a view toward bringing about his or her nomination or election; or

(3) If after written notification by the Commission that any other person is receiving contributions or making expenditures on the individual's behalf, the individual fails to disavow this activity by letter to the Commission within 30 days of receipt of the notification; or

(4) The individual otherwise seeks nomination or election to Federal office whether or not the individual is elected.

Form 2 must be filed within a reasonable time after attaining candidate status.

B. WHAT INFORMATION IS REQUIRED

Each individual who becomes a candidate for nomination or election to Federal office is required to designate the following:

1) a principal campaign committee (Line 6) (2 U.S.C. 432(e));

2-15-77.

2) one or more national or State banks as his or her campaign depositories (Line 7) (2 U.S.C. 432(e));

3) whether the candidate will personally receive contributions and/or make expenditures and be filing separate reports, or whether he or she requests a waiver of reporting (Line 8) (2 U.S.C. 436(b)).

Each principal campaign committee is required to register and report without regard to the registration and reporting exemptions otherwise allowed to political committees.

C. WHERE TO FILE

Candidates seeking nomination or election as a Representative in or Delegate or Resident Commissioner to the Congress of the United States file with the Clerk of the House of Representatives, 1036 Longworth House Office Building, Washington, D.C. 20515. Candidates seeking nomination or election to the United States Senate, file with the Office of the Secretary of the Senate, 119 D Street N.E., Washington, D.C. 20510. Candidates seeking nomination or election to the Offices of the President or Vice President file with the Federal Election Commission 1325 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20463. A copy of this statement shall be filed with the Secretary of State (or, if there is no Office of Secretary of State, the equivalent State officer) of the appropriate State.

D. PENALTIES FOR FALSE REPORTING

Serious violations of this Act may subject a person to civil or criminal penalties up to three times the dollar value of the relevant contribution or expenditure or \$25,000 (whichever is greater), or one year in prison or both.

I was not aware of my obligation to file a pre-election report with the Federal Election Commission, as a stand-in vice-presidential candidate for the state of California. I certainly feel that no action should be taken against me, being incupably ignorant of the filing obligation; also the fact remains that we did not get on the ballot in California. There was no bank account in my name. The only monies spent by me were donations to McCarthy '76. and air fare to Madison, Wisconsin. Sincerely,

headquarters in Washington, D. C., to be used in his
campaign. Not in letter. The total amount was less
than \$200.00. Begin letter again. A copy of his report
I am told has or will be filed with the Federal Election
Commission. As far as I know none of this money was used
to further my candidacy.

If I am responsible for any other report, please
advise. End of letter to Kentucky Registrar.

I have not received any further letters from the Ky.
Commission.

Since I ran only as a stand-in candidate in Ky., and
did not appoint any committees or anyone to raise money
in my behalf, nor solicit or receive any, and the money
my wife and I contributed was to McCarthy's candidacy for
President, I didn't think it necessary to burden you with
such a negative report.

With one exception, I did not campaign. I did attend
a "so called advertised non-partisan open political speaking"
sponsored by a certain church, but I was refused by the
pastor and sponsoring committee to speak. That was the
beginning and end of my campaigning.

I have been trying to forget the past election and
apply my remaining strength to more enjoyable and rewarding
things. I hope this letter will fulfill all that is

2 U.S.C. §431(b) and (c). The presidential candidate has the obligation to designate the principal campaign committee and the depository which, by statute, is also the committee and the depository of the V.P. candidate.

2 U.S.C. §§432(e) and 437(c). Under §434, however, no special rules apply to V.P. candidates with respect to reporting receipts and expenditures.

DO EACH OF THESE CANDIDATES HAVE TO FILE A STATEMENT AS WELL AS THEIR NAME BE INCLUDED ON THE PRINCIPAL CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE REPORT? ALSO, IN A CASE WHERE WE HAVE A PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE FILING WITH US AND THEIR PRINCIPAL CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE BUT THE VICE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE HAS NOT.

PLEASE LET ME KNOW THE LEGAL INTERPRETATION OF VP FILING REQUIREMENTS AND IF THEY DO HAVE TO FILE WE NEED A 48 HOUR DRAFT LETTER TO GO TO MCCARTHY'S COMMITTEE.
