

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION

Complainant alleges respondent distributed posters and handouts for a campaign related "political coffee" at Spalding College without a notice of authorization or unauthorization. Complainant also alleges respondent failed to report a contribution in kind from Spalding College for this same coffee or any expenditures in connection with the coffee.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

Complainant failed to provide the Commission with any evidence substantiating his allegations. He has also failed to supply the allegedly violative handout. Due to the lack of evidence, we are of the view there is no reason to believe a violation has been committed.

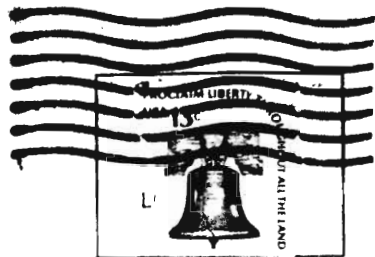
