Dear Commissioners:

This complaint, filed by Mr. John Nolan, Chairman, Republican County Committee of Saratoga County, 77 Van Dam Street, Saratoga Springs, NY 12866 (hereinafter ("Complainant")), in accordance with 2 U.S.C. Sec. 437g(a)(1) and 11 CFR Sec. 101.3 (a)(b), alleges violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) of 1971, as amended, by Bob Lawrence for Congress, P.O. Box 489, East Greenbush, NY 12061-0489, and William C. Hennessey, Jr., it's treasurer, (hereinafter, "Respondent"). Respondent has violated Federal election law by not reporting the receipt of contributions from Political Action Committees during that period required by law.

LAW

Respondent is a candidate for election to the United States House of Representatives from the Twenty-fourth Congressional District of New York. Respondent is bound by Federal election law, specifically 11 CFR Sec. 103.3(a), which reads in substantial part:

"All receipts by a political committee shall be deposited in account(s) established pursuant to 11 CFR Sec. 103.2,...The treasurer of the committee shall be responsible for making such deposits. All deposits shall be made within 10 days of the treasurer's receipt." Moreover, at 11 CFR Sec. 104.3(a)(3), it states that "An authorized committee of a candidate for Federal office shall report the total amount of receipts received during the reporting period (emphasis added) and, except for itemized and unitemized breakdowns, during the calendar year in each of the following categories:". One such category, described at 11 CFR Sec. 104.3(a)(3)(iv), specifies that committees shall report "Contributions from committees, including contributions from committees which are not political committees under the Act, but excluding contributions from any party committees". Most specifically, 11 CFR Sec. 104.3(a)(4) states:

"The identification...of each contributor and the aggregate year to date total for such contributor in each of the following categories shall be reported." (ii) "All committees (including political committees and committees which do not qualify as political committees under the Act) which make contributions to the reporting committee during the reporting period, together with the date of receipt and amount of any such contribution."

FACT

Respondent, in accordance with a memorandum issued by the Federal Election Commission (See Exhibit A) to Congressional campaigns in the State of New York dated August 6, 1990, is required to have reported "All financial activity that occurred during the reporting period (or before, if not previously reported)".

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Congressional campaigns in the State of New York are required to have reported all activity during the period of 07/01/90 through 08/22/90 in their Pre-Primary reports. Further, some are required to have reported all activity covering the period from 08/23/90 through 09/30/90 in their October Quarterly Report.

Respondent received contributions from three Political Action Committees on the following dates: July 27, 1990, August 1, 1990, and August 9, 1990. This is known because Respondent reported these contributions. Respondent reported these contributions, received during the Pre-Primary reporting period, on it's subsequent, Third Quarter Report (See Exhibit C), even though this report does NOT cover the period during which these contributions were received and is therefore, the wrong report in which to report such contributions. The latest of these contributions, received August 9th, 1990 was received a full thirteen days before the close of books on the Pre-Primary report. Even if Respondent did not deposit the August 9th contribution for the full 10 days permitted him under the Act, the contribution would still have had to have been deposited by August 19th, fully three days before the close of Pre-Primary Report books (See Exhibit B).

It is irrelevant here that Respondent, during the primary campaign, has repeatedly condemned the practice of accepting contributions from such groups. It is also irrelevant that Respondent pointedly criticizes his general election opponent for accepting such Political Action Committee or "PAC" contributions.

What is material here is that Respondent deliberately did not report the receipt of certain contributions in the appropriate report as required by law. The result of this misreporting of contributions was that the public was denied important contribution information until after an election was held.

Complainant requests that the Federal Election Commission investigate and discover why these violations have occurred.

Complainant also reserves the right to amend and supplement this complaint at any time in the future.

REPORTING FORMS

Candidate committees use Form 3 (enclosed). If the campaign has more than one authorized committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report on Form 3Z.

WHERE TO FILE

Consult the instructions on the back of the Form 3 Summary Page. Note state filing requirements also.

LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Corrections should be made on the label.

LAST-MINUTE CONTRIBUTIONS

Committees must also file special notices on contributions of \$1,000 or more, received during the period August 23 through September 8, 1990. The notice must reach the appropriate federal and state offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt.

COMPLIANCE

TREASURERS OF POLITICAL COMMITTEES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FILING ALL REPORTS ON TIME. FAILURE TO DO SO IS SUBJECT TO ENFORCEMENT ACTION. COMMITTEES FILING ILLEGIBLE REPORTS OR USING NON-FEC FORMS WILL BE REQUIRED TO REFILE.

1/The period begins with the close of the last report filed by the committee. If the committee has filed no previous reports, the period begins with the date of the committee's first activity.

2/Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked by the mailing date. Otherwise, they must be received by the filing date.






I. GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter arises from a complaint filed with The Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") alleging that Bob Lawrence for Congress, and William C. Hennessy, Jr., as treasurer, ("the Committee") violated The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), by failing to timely report certain receipts as required. 2 U.S.C. § 434(b). The Commission has received a response from the Committee (Attachment I).

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

A. The Law

The Act provides that the treasurer of a principal campaign committee of a candidate for the House of Representatives must

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file, in a year when there is a regularly held election for which the candidate is seeking election, or nomination for election, a pre-election report. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(i). Such report must contain for the reporting period the total amounts of all receipts from contributions from other political committees, including the identity of the committee together with the date and amount of the contribution. 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(2)(D), (3)(B).

B. Application of The Law

Bob Lawrence was a candidate in 1990 for election to the United States House of Representatives from the twenty fourth congressional district of New York. Mr. Lawrence designated Bob Lawrence for Congress as his principal campaign committee. The primary was held on September 11, 1990. In 1990, the Committee was required to file a pre-primary report on August 30, 1990, covering all financial activity from July 1, 1990 to August 22, 1990.

The complaint cites three separate contributions as not having been timely reported. These contributions were reported by the Committee in its October quarterly report as having been received on July 27, 1990, August 1, 1990, and August 9, 1990. The complaint asserts that these contributions should have been reported on the Committee's pre-primary report, as they were received between July 1, 1990, and August 22, 1990, the coverage dates for that report. Instead, the contributions apparently were first disclosed on the Committee's October Quarterly report, filed after the primary election. The complaint notes

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that even allowing for a 10 day delay between receipt and deposit, as permitted under the Commission's regulations, see 11 C.F.R. § 103.3(a), the contributions were within the pre-primary report's coverage dates.¹

The complaint further alleges that the Committee's failure to report in a timely manner was deliberate. It notes the Committee's condemnation, throughout the primary campaign, of the practice by candidates of accepting contributions from Political Action Committees ("PACs"). The complaint implies that the Committee's failure to timely disclose these contributions was a deliberate attempt to prevent the public from knowing prior to the election that it too had accepted contributions from PACs.

Bob Lawrence for Congress in its response asserts that the contributions at issue in the complaint were recorded as having been received on the dates when they were, in fact, made.² As

1. The complainant appears to be under the misconception that "receipt" for purposes of the reporting obligations occurs when the contributions are deposited by the treasurer. In fact, the date of receipt for purposes of the Act is the date on which the committee comes into possession of the contribution and not the date on which the contribution is deposited by the treasurer. See 11 C.F.R. § 102.8(a). Accordingly, the Committee would be required to report its contributions on the date it took possession of them.

2. The response refers only to the date the contributions were "generated", but the response's description of the checks' routing process of first being delivered to local entities associated with the contributors, then to the campaign committee, and finally to the treasurer and deposited, suggests that "generated" means the date on which the checks were written by the contributors. Irrespective of the term's meaning, the Committee contends that the receipt dates as reported are incorrect.

such, the response continues, they were in reality received on a later day than reported. While failing to give the exact dates of receipt, the response asserts that the contributions were in fact received after August 22, 1990, outside the pre-primary report's coverage dates.

This contention is supported by the relevant documents. The disbursement dates as reported by two of the contributing entities on their disclosure reports for the contributions correspond to the receipt dates as reported by the Committee.³ Moreover, the dates on the copies of the checks for the three contributions likewise correspond to the receipt dates as reported by the Committee. See Attachment I, p. 2. It should be noted, however, that copies of only the front of the checks were provided by the respondent, leaving the date of receipt issue unresolved as any endorsements evidencing receipt would necessarily be on the back of the checks. Irrespective of the lack of conclusive evidence concerning the actual dates of receipt, there is a strong indication, as evidenced by the correlation between the Committee's reported receipt dates and the disbursement dates on the documents mentioned above, that the Committee did in fact misreport the dates of receipt. Consequently, it would appear that the contributions were in fact received on a date later than reported.

3. No reported disbursement date is available for Adirondack & Vicinity District Council of Carpenters' \$40 contribution.

An examination of the Committee's October quarterly report suggests that in addition to the contributions mentioned in the complaint, there may be two other contributions from PACs which were likewise misreported. These involve contributions reported as having been received on August 15, 1990, and August 16, 1990, well within the coverage dates for the pre-primary report.

Concerning the complaint's allegation that the apparent delinquency of the disclosures was deliberate, it should be noted that the Committee did report contributions from PACs in its pre-primary report.⁴ This fact effectively negates the complaint's allegation of the deliberate misreporting as it serves to eliminate the implied motive.

Although it is presently unclear what the actual dates of receipt were for the five contributions at issue, there is no definite indication that they were reported in an untimely manner. There is evidence indicating that the receipt dates as reported are incorrect. Further, it does not appear that the misreporting was deliberate nor that the sums involved were substantial.⁵ Therefore, this Office recommends that the Commission find reason to believe Bob Lawrence for Congress, and William C. Hennessy, Jr., as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(B), and take no further action.

4. On its pre-primary report the Committee reported three separate contributions, totaling \$2,000, from PACs.

5. Receipts for the five contributions at issue total \$5,040.

In light of the Committee's expressed willingness to amend its October quarterly report to reflect the correct dates of receipt, this Office intends to contact the Committee by letter admonishing it that all disclosures of contributions from other political committees must contain the actual date of receipt for the contribution and advising it to amend its quarterly report to reflect the correct dates of receipt for the five contributions at issue. Alternatively, if the receipt dates as reported prove to be correct the Committee would be required to amend its pre-primary report to reflect the receipt of these contributions.⁶

III. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that Bob Lawrence for Congress, and William C. Hennessy, Jr., as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(b) and take no further action.
2. Approve the appropriate letter.
3. Approve the attached Factual and Legal Analysis.

6. A Request for Additional Information was previously sent by the Reports Analysis Division concerning, among other things, the discrepancies presently at issue. The Committee's subsequent amendment to its October quarterly report, however, failed to correct these discrepancies.

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4. Close the file.

Although it is presently unclear what the actual dates of receipt were for the five contributions at issue, there is no definite indication that they were reported in an untimely manner. There is evidence indicating that the receipt dates as reported are incorrect. Further, it does not appear that the misreporting was deliberate nor that the sums involved were substantial.⁵ Therefore, the Commission found reason to believe that Bob Lawrence for Congress, and William C. Hennessy, Jr., as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(B), but under the circumstances determined to take no further action.
