SUBJECT: MUR 3677- Narrative

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you that the first sentence and the last sentence in the first paragraph of the narrative for MUR 3677, Citizens for Arlen Specter require amendment.

The first sentence currently reads "[c]omplainant Sidney D. Rosenblatt alleged that Citizens for Arlen Specter, an unregistered entity...." (emphasis added), but should read "[c]omplainant Sidney D. Rosenblatt alleged that an unregistered entity...." The last sentence currently reads "[a]fter the complaint was filed, the Committee reported receipts of \$7,300...." but should read "[a]fter the complaint was filed, the independent committee reported receipts of \$7,300...." (Emphasis added).

The revised narrative will be placed on the public record for MUR 3677 and sent to the complainant and respondents in this matter.

Dear Mr. Noble:

On behalf of our client, Sidney D. Rosenblatt, a citizen of Pennsylvania, we write respectfully to request that the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "FEC" or "Commission") investigate apparent violations of the Commission's regulations by Citizens for Arlen Specter, the campaign committee authorized by Senator Arlen Specter, and/or the "Independent Senatorial Committee," purporting to have placed advertisements expressly advocating the reelection of Senator Specter in the October 22, 1992 edition of the Jewish Times and in the October 23, 1992 edition of the Jewish Exponent (copies of the two advertisements are attached hereto as Exhibit A). Mr. Rosenblatt has requested our representation in this matter both in his capacity as a citizen and as Treasurer of the campaign committee authorized by Lynn Yeakel, the candidate opposing Senator Specter in the November 3, 1992 General Election.

According to the public records office of the FEC, the Independent Senatorial Committee was not registered with it as a political committee as of today at 10:20 a.m. (as confirmed with Katherine Lowder of the FEC public records office staff). Nor, according to Pam Gavin, Superintendent of the Senate Office of Public Records, Secretary of the Senate, was it registered with that office, as of today at 10:30 a.m.. The advertisements in question indicate that they were "paid by INDEPENDENT SENATORIAL COMMITTEE, Edward H. Rosen, Treasurer" and contain an alphabetical list of contributors "COMPLETE AS OF OCTOBER 19, 1992."

We believe the placement of the challenged advertisements was not an independent expenditure as defined in the Federal Campaign Practices Act, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431(17), and in the Regulations, 45 C.F.R. § 109.1(a), and that it therefore violates the in-kind contribution limits established

by the Act, 2 U.S.C. § 441(a)(7)(B). There is strong evidence that the "Independent Senatorial Committee" (hereinafter "ISC") is in fact authorized by or actively affiliated with Citizens for Arlen Specter (hereinafter "CAS"), Senator Specter's principal campaign committee, and that ISC is a single candidate committee formed solely for the purpose of evading the legal limits on contributions to the Specter campaign. This evidence includes:

- 1) Of the 91 individuals listed in the advertisements, 20 have already made the maximum allowable contribution to CAS, according to FEC records. Another 16 individuals have contributed lesser sums to CAS, according to FEC records. A list of these individuals, the amount(s) and date(s) of their contribution(s), and the designation "Y" or "N" to indicate whether or not they have already made the maximum allowable contribution, together with copies of the supporting FEC documents, are attached as Exhibit B.
- 2) Edward H. Rosen, the Treasurer of the ISC, has been actively involved with CAS and appears to be actively coordinating the activities of the ISC with the Specter campaign. We have first-hand knowledge that on October 12, 1992, Mr. Rosen solicited individuals for contributions to the ISC at a candidate forum at which Senator Specter was the sole speaker, stating that his purpose was to enable persons who had already made the maximum contribution to the Specter campaign to make additional contributions and that the ISC intended to take out an advertisement in the Jewish Exponent urging Specter's re-election. In addition, Mr. Rosen served as a surrogate for Senator Specter in a candidates' forum sponsored by Germantown Jewish Center which took place in Philadelphia on October 11, 1992. Further, Mr. Rosen, joined with eleven other individuals, all of whom are listed as ISC members in the advertisements, in a letter to the editor strongly supporting Senator Specter's candidacy which was printed in the October 9, 1992 edition of the Jewish Exponent (a copy of which is attached as Exhibit C). Mr. Rosen and 12 other members of the ISC (Jerome Epstein, Deborah Epstein, Gary Erlbaum, Vicki Erlbaum, Robert Golder, Ronald Rubin, Bubbles Seidenberg, Howard Silverman, Connie Smukler, Joseph Smukler, Mark Solomon, Carole Solomon) were among the sponsors of a \$1,000 per person luncheon for Senator Specter on June 22, 1992 (copy of invitation, directing RSVPs to call the telephone number of CAS, attached as Exhibit D and a copy of CAS letterhead indicating its telephone number to be (215) 574-1922 attached as Exhibit E). Finally, Mr. Rosen, together with

seven other of the individuals listed as members of the ISC in the advertisement (Evelyn Bodek a/k/a Evelyn Bodek Rosen, Howard Cohen, Gary Erlbaum, Ronald Rubin, Miriam Schneirov a/k/a Mimi Schneirov, Bubbles Seidenberg, Vivian Young) were listed as members of a "Community Committee for Arlen Specter" in a political advertisement in the March 6, 1992 edition of the Jewish Exponent paid for and authorized by CAS (copy attached as Exhibit F).

- 3) Eight of the members of the ISC (Barbara Cohen, Gerri Fox, Rosalie Gerson, Evelyn Rosen, Lynn Ross, Ellen Saft, Mildred Tessler, Vivian Young) were among the members of the "Steering Committee" and the "Support Committee" for a "community meeting" to meet Senator Specter, for which RSVPs and requests for information were directed to the telephone number of CAS (copy attached as Exhibit G).

Alternatively, even if the placement of the advertisements by the Independent Senatorial Committee represents a legitimate independent expenditure on behalf of Senator Specter's re-election campaign, it appears that several FEC regulations have been violated.


- 1) The ISC has not registered a Statement of Organization with the FEC within ten days of becoming a political committee (i.e. within ten days of receiving contributions aggregating in excess of \$1,000 or within ten days of spending in excess of \$1,000 for the advertisements), in violation of 45 C.F.R. §§ 100.5 and 102.1(d). As indicated in the attached rate schedule (Exhibit H), the fee for full-page political advertisements placed in both the Jewish Exponent and the Jewish Times is normally \$3,667.65; the deadline for placement of ads is normally one week before or no later than the Monday before the publication date (in this case, October 16 or October 19).
- 2) The ISC has not reported an independent expenditure aggregating \$1,000 or more within 24 hours after such expenditure was made, in violation of 45 C.F.R. § 104.4(b) if it is a political committee, or alternatively, in violation of 45 C.F.R. § 109.2(b) if it is not a political committee.
- 3) The advertisements fail to include the disclaimer required by 45 C.F.R. § 110.11(a)(1)(iii), that the communication was not authorized by Senator Specter or Citizens for Arlen Specter.



### Anti-Yeakel flap echoes Willie Horton

Several things should be kept in mind when considering the controversy surrounding Lynn Yeakel and her church, Bryn Mawr Presbyterian. First, Lynn Yeakel has been outspoken in her support for Israel and has never, in over 30 years of public life, done or said anything that could remotely be construed as anti-Semitic.

Participants in forums on the Middle East held by the church made statements critical of Israel spoke only for themselves, not for her or her church, and she has repeatedly stated to the press and the individuals involved that she disagrees strongly with their views.

Second, the church ran the forums as part of its numerous community outreach activities and its longstanding interest in current affairs, and anti-Israel statements made in the context of wide-ranging discussions were no more representative of the position of the church and its members than letters to the editor are representative of the position of a newspaper.

Finally, it should not be necessary to point out that in open discussions on any topic, views with which you disagree will inevitably be heard, and that criticism of policies of the State of Israel does not necessarily equate with anti-Semitism.

In a kind of Orwellian logic, however, Arlen Specter and his supporters insist that the church's willingness to sponsor free and open debate on the Middle East is by definition anti-Semitic, and demand that Lynn Yeakel disavow her church for behaving in accordance with principles of freedom of the pulpit and freedom of conscience, which Presbyterians hold sacred.

This campaign, a sickening variation on the theme of the infamous Willie Horton ads of 1988, sank to new depths with the nationwide distribution of a letter attempting to link Lynn Yeakel and her church to Arab "broadcast terrorists."

Freedom of religion was so important to the founders of America that it is the only right enumerated in both the original Constitution and the Bill of Rights. But Mr. Specter obviously hopes that the Jewish community, fearful of anti-Semitism and haunted by memories of the Holocaust, will now declare that freedom of religion applies to every



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church but Bryn Mawr Presbyterian, that freedom of speech applies to everyone but members of that church and that the prohibition of a religious test as a qualification for office applies to every candidate but Lynn Yeakel.

I am Jewish and American, and proud of both, and I personally am not ready to follow Arlen Specter lemminglike into the abyss of ethnic and religious strife that will turn this nation into another Northern Ireland or Bosnia if his politics of fear becomes the norm.

If we act out of fear of others, we will bring about the very thing we dread most, for Israel will not long survive in a world with an America shattered by hatred.

### Beware the changing of senatorial guard

There is a malignancy in passivity. This speaks to the core of collective angst sustained by many people in the Jewish community regarding Lynn Yeakel's non-response to her church's activities.

Space does not permit the "listing" of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian's "Israel-bashing." Suffice it to say there is sufficient documentation — places, dates, direct quotes from specific members of the church's hierarchy during these last few years — to negate the accusations by the Yeakel camp of "untruths, smear campaigns, guilt by association," etc.

Anyone can write position papers. But the "promise" by someone new to the political arena with no tangible track record is precarious at best. This, coupled with Ms. Yeakel's seeming insensitivity to the raw nerve-endings attendant to our history — the residuals of our grisly past — would certainly tend to heighten the risk.

If she is so uncomprehending about our exasperation with her, how can she be entrusted to sense when Israel is at jeopardy?

She professes great concern about Israel's future, yet she has never managed to visit the country as have millions of other curious tourists (many of them non-Jewish). Nor did she even bother to attend one of the many conferences on the Middle East held right in her own church (where she holds high office). One must wonder how this "concern" might manifest itself if she wins the senatorial seat.

In his editorial of Sept. 21, in the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, Dan Rosenberg refers to the Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church as a "victim" and "innocent bystander." Representing that church thusly is like claiming Martin Borman gave Talmudic readings during his coffee breaks.

The oversimplistic binary about what did and didn't happen at that church exemplifies the "Big Lie" concept — tell it often enough with just the right touch of outrage and it will stick! And I fear I must accuse

Ms. Yeakel of directly participating in the "Big Lie."

At a reception for her on Aug. 3, I personally heard her say in response to questions about her church: "It was a one-time occurrence a couple of years back, which I did not attend, and of which I had no previous knowledge" — and all of this delivered with an edge of annoyance from a platform of self-righteous indignation.

Yes, I am eager to see many more women in government, and yes, I was outraged by her opponents' political "black moment," almost choking on the bile of my censure and the need to be punitive. But stepping aside from that anger in search of objectivity, a larger picture looms, perhaps a bit ominously.

I confess a memory being nudged and disquieted by the refrain, "Less we forget." Have we forgotten already? Is pulling a straight lever more compelling than a Jewish conscience?

We cannot afford an erosion of our awareness. We cannot allow our vigil of anti-Semitism to slip. I would urge my fellow Zionists to move beyond their mindset, and get off the handwagon that panders to the whitewash of pernicious, anti-Israel propaganda!

And I would entreat: Beware the changing of the guard.

or reported. It was fascinating, in the interview, to read his response to his feelings about his Jewishness. It is clear that he was not certain about the reasons for Jewish existence.

He mentions that his child married an Armenian and that his grandchildren are conversant with their Armenian ancestry, but know nothing of their Jewish ancestry. He mildly bemoans the fact that he submerged his own heritage, never passed it on and now sees it totally absent in his descendants.

There is a sense of loss in his own life that is so uncharacteristic of the man. It is voiced as a mildly interesting fact, but without the passion of so many of his other statements.

If anything, there was no ambivalence in Sidney Hook's intellectual or public positions. He was brilliant, and his writings display a clarity that made him a powerful advocate and enemy. For many of us, he was an authentic source for political sanity at a time when, as young minds, we were struggling for meaningful positions.

Yes, as a Jew, he could not arrive at the same clarity. At the end, there was some nostalgia, some regrets and, above all, silence. The contrast is vivid.

Sidney Hook was not alone in that bifurcation. It is tragic to think how many brilliant Jews fought major battles without compromise on the public and academic scene. They took unpopular and, at times, isolated positions without hesitation. Yet, when it came to their Jewishness, there was a contrasting retreat of mind and spirit.

Even when pressed for response, there is not the same convulsive burst of brilliant and introspective surety. The subject is either too disturbing or just seen as an interruption.

It is important to remember the Sidney Hooks at a time when the American Jewish community worries about its future. Statistics are quoted to illustrate the frightening demographics in our community. Yet, a meaningful contrast appears with the realities of the 1940s.

Consult publication lists, the indexes and tables of contents of major intellectual journals, the lecture circuit or television shows. A significant number of young Jewish scholars are featured prominently and frequently. Even in the social sciences, you now find major figures who are identified with Judaism and the Jewish people.

These intellectual spokespersons are not vocal about their expertise and silent about their Judaism, as were the masters of the past. They're comfortable to speak even from the perspective of their Jewish identification.

Obviously, it is a difficult and dangerous time for the future of the Jewish people. Yet, there are hopeful signs as well. There are vivid, powerful and even strident voices who are speaking as Jews. It is being done without shame or hesitation.

They have to be influential in the thinking of the next generation. They are the teachers, and they could be the architects of a secure and intellectually acute Jewish generation. Hopefully, it will be that influence and that tone that will be the saving features in an uncertain future. ■





This reply would have been more prompt had I been in the country. I have just returned from a ten day trip to Europe with the United States Holocaust Memorial Council, of which I am a member. Since your letter is dated November 9, I am sure that this reply is, nevertheless, timely.

I would like to handle the matter without benefit of counsel because the Independent Senatorial Committee has only very limited funds left after the recent election.

I have read Mr. Harvey's complaint and much of what he says is correct. I have in fact been and still am an active supporter of Arlen Specter and of other Senators, of both parties, with whose voting record and/or policies I concur. I did appear on Specter's behalf as is said and I've been supportive in many other ways.

My wife and I at a meeting with Constance and Joseph Smukler decided to form the ISC. Constance serves as Assistant Treasurer and she and Mr. Smukler wrote the copy for the ad. I wrote the copy for the Kasten ad and that's the story of the ISC. We then started soliciting \$100 contributions, indicating that we were going to run ads for Specter and others whose policies we wanted to support. Some of our contributors offered \$200 and a few, myself included gave \$500. I enclose the list of our contributors and the amounts given.

We then inserted the ads which are reproduced in the complaint and one other ad in the Milwaukee Journal for Senator Kasten. Attached you will find the costs of each.


At no time did I speak with Specter, anyone on Specter's staff or his family about this initiative. Though I also know Senator Kasten the same thing applies to him.

Subsequently I mailed the "Statement of Organization" to the Secretary of the Senate and a list of expenditures to pay for the three ads. A copy of those statements is enclosed.

Other than not filing precisely on time I believe I have made a sincere effort to comply with the regulations of the FEC and the Secretary of the Senate. On behalf of the Citizens For Arlen Specter ("CAS"), I am writing in response to your November 9, 1992 letter.

It appears that the Yeakel Campaign, to garner media attention, directed a scandalously speculative, baseless complaint against CAS immediately before the November 3, 1992 Election. The Yeakel Campaign is thus abusing the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") and its processes -- actions that I trust the FEC will condemn.

On its face, the "complaint," verified by Yeakel Campaign Treasurer Sidney Rosenblatt, does not even remotely show any impropriety on the part of CAS. Rosenblatt alleges that a group of supporters of Senator Specter -- some of whom had already contributed \$1,000 to CAS -- formed the Independent Senatorial Committee ("ISC") and placed two local newspaper ads endorsing Senator Specter's re-election. By hearsay accounts, the ISC's purported Treasurer, Edward Rosen, solicited support for this effort at one of Senator Specter's candidate forums.

Assuming all these facts are true -- a highly dubious assumption, given the abusive manner in which this "complaint" was fed to the media -- there is no allegation that ISC took its actions "with the cooperation or with the prior consent of, or in consultation with, or at the suggestion of" CAS. 11 CFR §109.1(a)(4). On the contrary, at most, the Yeakel Complaint suggests that a group of ardent supporters of Senator Specter took independent action to promote his re-election. This constitutionally-protected activity is the lifeblood of participatory democracy.

To underscore that CAS has fully complied with the election laws and regulations, I have enclosed the affidavits of Patrick L. Meehan, CAS Campaign Manager, and Stephen J. Harmelin, CAS Treasurer. Mr. Meehan and Mr. Harmelin state, inter alia, that neither they, nor any agent of CAS arranged, coordinated, directed, authorized, or sanctioned ISC's activities. Mr. Meehan and Mr. Harmelin further state that the ISC acted without the cooperation, prior consent, request, or suggestion of CAS or its agents. There can thus be no question that the Yeakel Complaint is groundless and must be dismissed.

Finally, I note that the Yeakel Complaint includes various allegations respecting ISC's purported non-compliance with various regulations. Those allegations are properly directed to ISC, not CAS.





Rosenblatt alleged that Citizens for Arlen Specter, an unregistered entity whose founders and contributors are closely connected to the Specter campaign, purportedly made independent expenditures on behalf of the Specter campaign; resulting in excessive contributions, failure to register and file reports of receipts and expenditures, and failure to display the appropriate disclaimer on advertisements. Respondents replied that the independent committee was formed by Specter supporters to make contributions to run ads for Specter and others whose policies they supported, but without consultation with the candidates or their agents. After the complaint was filed, the Committee reported receipts of \$7,300 and expenditures of \$6,779 on behalf of Specter and another senator. Respondents admitted a lack of familiarity with the regulations.

Rosenblatt alleged that Citizens for Arlen Specter, an unregistered entity whose founders and contributors are closely connected to the Specter campaign, purportedly made independent expenditures on behalf of the Specter campaign; resulting in excessive contributions, failure to register and file reports of receipts and expenditures, and failure to display the appropriate disclaimer on advertisements. Respondents replied that the independent committee was formed by Specter supporters to make contributions to run ads for Specter and others whose policies they supported, but without consultation with the candidates or their agents. After the complaint was filed, the Committee reported receipts of \$7,300 and expenditures of \$6,779 on behalf of Specter and another senator. Respondents admitted a lack of familiarity with the regulations.

The amount of money involved is not substantial and does not warrant the significant resources necessary to establish what appear to be reporting violations.

On November 9, 1992, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients of a complaint alleging certain violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was enclosed with that notification.

After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission has determined to exercise its prosecutorial discretion and to take no action against Citizens for Arlen Specter and Stephen J. Harmelin, as treasurer. See attached narrative. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. While the file may be placed on the public record prior to receipt of your additional materials, any permissible submissions will be added to the public record when received.
