ALLEGATION:

Misappropriation of campaign funds by Raymond W. Myers, former press aide to Victor L. Crawford (candidate for U.S. Senate, Maryland).

REPORT:

After interview with counsel for People for Vic Crawford and examination of affidavit executed by Raymond W. Myers, it is apparent that the funds were misappropriated. However, Myers has refunded the money and Mr. Crawford is no longer interested in pursuing the matter. An examination of Mr. Crawford's October 10 candidate report shows that full disclosure has been made of the alleged misappropriation.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the information stated above, it is our opinion that this matter be transmitted to the Department of Justice. Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission close the case.



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



On September 10, 1975, I received a telephone call from Mr. Neil Axel, counsel for Victor Crawford, Senatorial candidate in Maryland. Mr. Axel stated the following:

1. On September 10, 1975, it became apparent to Mr. Crawford and his campaign manager that two checks had been written for non-campaign purposes.
 2. One check was drawn to a local bank in the amount of \$750 and another check was drawn to cash for \$250.
 3. Mr. Crawford and/or others spoke with the person involved and there are three or four stories concerning the checks.
 4. Mr. Axel was contemplating contacting the Department of Justice--both the United States and State of Maryland. Mr. Axel is also thinking of instituting a civil suit for diversion in order to depose the individual who allegedly diverted the funds to determine what if any other funds were diverted.
- Mr. Axel stated the purpose of this call was to insure full disclosure of the matter with the Commission. I assured him that the necessary people within the Commission would be notified of this call and that upon receipt of the letter, he stated he would send today, we would take whatever follow-up action was necessary.

1975, I decided to consider the possibility of discharging this individual. It was learned at approximately this time that the account was still open.


Accordingly, on September 3rd I went to the Suburban Trust Company to close out the account. In doing so, I discovered that there was a balance of only \$146.14 left in the account. Without disclosing our knowledge we casually questioned Mr. Myers concerning the account and he advised us that there were "several hundred dollars" remaining in the account and that he would give us a complete accounting of all monies spent. I requested forthwith a duplicate statement from the Bank since I suspected a possible misappropriation of funds and since no one was able to locate the original bank statement or cancelled checks.


On Sunday, September 7th, I discharged Mr. Myers because of the poor quality of his work. On Tuesday, September 9th, I received the duplicate of the bank statement and cancelled checks from the Suburban Trust Company which I had requested previously. In reviewing these documents, I learned that not only had Mr. Myers written checks in small amounts on this account for campaign purposes after my announcement, but that there was every indication that he had misappropriated to his own use at least \$750 from this account. On being questioned and confronted with the documents, Mr. Myers admitted to taking at least \$500 as a "loan" and further stating that he would attempt to pay the money back.

On Thursday, September 11th, after further verification, my attorney, Neil Edward Axel, contacted the Commission by phone and informed Steven Schachman of your office of the nature of this potential impropriety.

As indicated by my actions to date, I have attempted to search out the truth in this matter and notify the appropriate authorities thereof. Our investigation and efforts in this matter will continue. 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
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
