GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On August 16, 1978, the Reports Analysis Division referred, to the Office of the General Counsel, the name of Alice Conner, who failed to file her Statement of Candidacy, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §§432(e)(1) and 433(a).

An "informational notice" was sent on May 9, 1978. A "reason to believe" letter was sent by certified mail on June 23, 1978, and "reasonable cause to believe" notice was similarly sent on July 11, 1978.

The General Counsel's Office sent respondent a letter on August 29, 1978 requesting her to file her Statement of Candidacy within ten (10) days of her receipt of the letter. Respondent subsequently filed on September 12, 1978.

II. Analysis

In light of the fact that respondent Conner filed her Statement of Candidacy within the time period requested by the Office of the General Counsel, it is recommended that no further action be taken against respondent.

III. Recommendation
