





GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

The respondent, Michael Fieschko, has returned the Commission's conciliation agreement, signed, and with a check for \$250.00, the amount of the civil penalty stated in the agreement. No changes were proposed by the respondent to the agreement. This file cannot be closed as to Mr. Fieschko, however, until he files the reports that were the subject of this compliance action. Mr. Fieschko indicated that he would file the reports immediately.

As to respondent John Mahalchik, the Commission's certification indicates an RCTB finding was made on November 3, 1978. The respondent, however, had filed his Statement of Candidacy on October 2, 1978. Therefore, in light of the fact that Mahalchik filed his Statement of Candidacy, received no percentage of the vote in the general election, and the fact that the candidate has not reported the receipt or expenditure of any money in regard to the election, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the file be closed at this time.

The justification for the disparate treatment of respondents Fieschko and Mahalchik lies in the fact that Mahalchik has filed

a termination report and reported receiving no contributions or making any expenditures. Fieschko has not filed any reports, (thus the Commission has no information on his contributions or expenditures), and he received 5% of the vote in the general election.

Recommendations:




Respondent Fieschko received his conciliation agreement on November 14, 1978 for failing to file his Statement of Candidacy. After being unable to obtain the respondent's telephone number for several months, it was finally obtained through the respondent's father in late December, 1978. On January 2, 1979, the respondent stated, in a telephone conversation with this office, that he would sign the conciliation agreement and mail it to the Commission, along with the civil penalty, by January 6, 1979.

Beginning January 11, 1979, when the Commission had not received the signed agreement or the civil penalty, this office, on numerous occasions unsuccessfully attempted to call the respondent at his office. 

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On August 15, 1978, the Reports Analysis Division referred, to the Office of the General Counsel, the names of four(4) New Jersey candidates who failed to file their Statement of Candidacy designating a principal campaign committee, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §432(e)(1).

An informational notice was sent to the candidates by the Public Information Division on May 9, 1978. "Reason to believe" notices were sent by certified mail on June 16, 1978, and "reasonable cause to believe" notices were similarly sent on July 6, 1978. On August 29, 1978, the Office of the General Counsel sent letters and the appropriate form to three of the four non-filers, instructing them to fill out and return the forms (letter attached).

II. Analysis

- A. Respondent Austin subsequently filed on September 8, 1978, and the General Counsel's Office recommends that no further action be taken against him at this time.
- B. Respondent McGlory, unlike the other three respondents, was not sent a letter from the General Counsel's Office on August 29, 1978. It was discovered that she has been in the Ocean County Jail in Toms River, N.J. for almost a year, and therefore the General Counsel's Office recommends that no further action be taken against her at this time.

C. Respondents Fieschko and Mahalchik have still failed to file. Therefore, the General Counsel's Office recommends that compliance action with these respondents be continued.



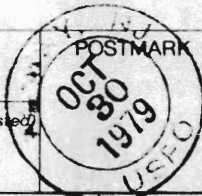

Michael Fieschko was a candidate for election to Federal office as a representative in the United States Congress from the Fifteenth Congressional District in the State of New Jersey, in 1978.

On July 6, 1978, the Commission determined that there was reasonable cause to believe that Michael Fieschko violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 101.2, by failing to file a statement of candidacy as required by 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 101.2. Mr. Fieschko was notified of the Commission's action by letter dated November 3, 1978, which enclosed a proposed conciliation agreement. Mr. Fieschko received the Commission's proposed conciliation agreement on November 14, 1978.

The Commission received the above described conciliation agreement signed by Mr. Fieschko and a check for \$250.00 on February 16, 1979. The agreement required the payment of a \$250.00 civil penalty and stated that if the Commission believes that the conciliation agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

The Commission sent Mr. Fieschko's \$250.00 check in payment of the civil penalty in for deposit on April 30, 1979. Mr. Fieschko's check was returned to the Commission for insufficient funds on May 29, 1979. A staff member in the Office of the General Counsel at the Commission called Mr. Fieschko to inform him that his check was returned for insufficient funds on May 30, 1979. Mr. Fieschko stated that he would mail in another check.

On July 3, 1979, when Mr. Fieschko still had not mailed in another check for \$250.00, a Commission staff member called Mr. Fieschko to determine why he had not mailed the check. Mr. Fieschko stated that he would mail the check to the Commission. On July 13, 1979, when Mr. Fieschko still had not mailed a \$250.00

check to the Commission, he was called again by a Commission staff member. Mr. Fieschko stated that he would send the Commission a \$125.00 check by July 20, 1979, and another \$125.00 check by July 31, 1979. When the July 20, 1979, deadline passed without the Commission receiving the first \$125.00 check, Commission staff again called Mr. Fieschko. Mr. Fieschko stated that he mailed the check.

On August 20, 1979, the Commission received a check from Mr. Fieschko for only \$125.00 despite the fact that the deadline for the full \$250.00 had passed on July 31, 1979. A Commission staff member made two calls to Mr. Fieschko concerning the remaining \$125.00, but the calls were not returned. The first call was made on August 28, 1979, the second call was made on September 5, 1979. As of this date, Mr. Fieschko has paid only \$125.00 of the \$250.00 civil penalty he agreed to pay, in violation of the conciliation agreement.

In light of the above, the Office of General Counsel requests authority to file a civil action against Mr. Fieschko to collect the unpaid balance of \$125.00 of the civil penalty agreed upon in the signed conciliation agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize civil suit.
