

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

ALLEGATION

The respondent committee is in violation of 2 U.S.C. 433 for failure to file a statement of organization for a political committee.

PREVIOUS COMMISSION ACTION

The Commission found reason to believe on September 8, 1978 and reasonable cause to believe on September 28, 1978, that the respondent violated 2 U.S.C. 433. The matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel on November 15, 1978.

EVIDENCE

Charles Gordon Vick, the candidate of the respondent committee, received 4,020 votes in the Tennessee Democratic Primary for .8% of the total. Mr. Vick's reports show no receipts and no expenditures.

Mr. Vick was telephoned on November 20, 1978. After an explanation of the situation was given, he seemed to agree to file the form required (FEC Form 1). However, on November 20, 1978, we received a reply from Mr. Vick indicating that he saw no need to file the form as he did not anticipate receiving or

expending (and did not receive or expend) more than \$1,000.
Accordingly, the form was not completed and filed.


ANALYSIS

In view of Mr. Vick's showing in the election and the fact that no money was apparently received or spent in his Senate quest, the Commission's non-filer guidelines indicate that this matter should be closed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Take no further action and close the file.
2. Approve the attached letter.
