This matter having been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of the Commission's supervisory responsibilities, an investigation having been conducted, and the Commission having found reasonable cause to believe that respondent Judson W. Robinson for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §434(b) (2) and (9) by failing to disclose in its 30 Day Post general election report the occupations and principal places of business of contributors of over \$100, and by failing to identify persons to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 were made.

Therefore, the Federal Election Commission and respondent, Judson W. Robinson for Congress Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a) (5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against it in this matter.

III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this Agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

- A. Respondent Judson W. Robinson for Congress Committee was the principal campaign committee for Judson W. Robinson during the 1978 General Election.
- B. In its 30 Day Post General Election report it failed to disclose the occupations and principal places of business of contributors of over \$100 and failed to identify each person to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 were made.
- C. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2) a political committee is required to disclose the occupations and principal places of business of contributors of over \$100 and pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(9) a political committee is required to identify each person to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 are made.

WHEREFORE Respondent agrees:

- V. Respondent's action in failing to disclose the occupations and principal places of business of contributors of over \$100 was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2).

- VI. Respondent's action in failing to identify each person to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 were made was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(9).
- VII. That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$150.00 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(6)(B).
- VIII. That pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(2) and (9) it will attempt to amend its reports disclosing the occupation and principal places of business of all contributors of over \$100.00, and identifying each person to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 were made.
- XI. That it will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431, et seq.


GENERAL CONDITIONS

If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.







Dear Mr. Sterling:

In regards to the proposed Conciliation Agreement for the above Committee, the Committee has not been functional and has disbanded since July 1978. The Committee's Candidate was defeated in the May 1978 primary elections and has not sought nor intends to seek election to federal office in the future. The primary election left the committee with a deficit balance represented by a note to a bank which the balance of which candidate is personally obligated to discharge.

I have no objection to executing the Conciliation Agreement, however, I would delete paragraph VIII or modify it to state "That pursuant to 2 U. S. C. § 434 (b) (s) and (9), it will attempt to amend its reports ... were made." Additionally, the committee does not have the \$250.00 civil penalty you propose. I therefore recommend revision to paragraph VII to state "That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$10.00 pursuant to 2 U. S. C. § 437g (a) (6) (b)."

Please review these recommendations in the light of this Committee being non-functional.

Robinson for Congress Committee revealed that in 30 instances the occupations and/or principal places of business of contributors of over \$100 were not disclosed. Additionally, in 27 instances, the reports failed to disclose the addresses of recipients of expenditures in excess of \$100 and/or the purposes of the expenditures.

The Committee failed to respond to an RFAI sent on July 26, 1978. On January 29, 1979 the Committee responded to the Commission's reason to believe letter of October 16, 1978. However, this response was inadequate in that no amendments were made to correct the aforesaid violations. (see attachment)

2 USC §434(b)(2) requires that the occupations and principal places of business of contributors of over \$100 be disclosed. Under 2 USC §434(b)(9) persons to whom expenditures in excess of \$100 have been made must be identified and the purposes of the expenditures must be disclosed. In failing to meet either of these requirements, the Committee violated these sections of the Act.
