Attached is a list of political committees and their treasurers who failed to timely file the 2004 12 Day Pre-Primary Report for New York in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434(a). On August 10, 2004, Prior Notice was sent to the political committees and their treasurers, informing them that the report was due on September 2, 2004 and should cover the period from July 1, 2004 through August 25, 2004.

The committees appearing on the attached circulation report have failed to file their reports prior to four (4) days before the primary election (considered a non-filed report). In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties located within 11 CFR §111.43, the committees should be assessed the civil money penalties included on the attached list.

Recommendation

- (1) Find reason to believe that the political committees and their treasurers listed on the RTB Circulation Report violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a) and make a preliminary determination that the civil money penalties would be the amount indicated on the RTB Circulation Report.
- (2) Send the appropriate mailgrams.

THE FEDERAL ELECTION CAMPAIGN ACT OF 1971, AS AMENDED ("THE ACT"), REQUIRES THAT YOUR COMMITTEE FILE A 12 DAY PRE-PRIMARY REPORT OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS IN ANY CALENDAR YEAR DURING WHICH THERE IS A REGULARLY SCHEDULED ELECTION FOR WHICH THE CANDIDATE IS SEEKING ELECTION, OR NOMINATION FOR ELECTION. THIS REPORT, COVERING THE PERIOD THROUGH AUGUST 25, 2004, SHALL BE FILED NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 2, 2004. 2 U.S.C. 434(A). YOU WERE PREVIOUSLY NOTIFIED OF THE DUE DATE FOR THE REPORT. THE FEC WILL ONLY CONSIDER CHALLENGES THAT ARE BASED ON A FACTUAL ERROR, MISCALCULATION OF THE CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY BY THE FEC, OR THE EXISTENCE OF EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES THAT PERSISTED FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS THAT WERE BEYOND YOUR CONTROL AND PREVENTED YOU FROM FILING THE REPORT IN A TIMELY MANNER. IF YOU DO NOT PAY THE CALCULATED CIVIL MONEY PENALTY OR SUBMIT A CHALLENGE

The first report represents the committee that has paid the civil money penalty and the second report represents the committee that has not paid. The committee that has not paid has been given at least forty (40) days from the date of the Commission's RTB finding to remit payment.

In accordance with 11 C.F.R. 111.34 and 11 C.F.R. 111.40, the Commission shall send a final determination notice to those respondents that have either paid or not paid the civil money penalty.

ON 11/01/2004, THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION ("FEC") FOUND REASON TO BELIEVE ("RTB") THAT MEEKS FOR CONGRESS AND YOU, AS TREASURER, VIOLATED 2 U.S.C. 434(A) FOR FILING LATE OR FAILING TO FILE THE 2004 12 DAY PRE-PRIMARY REPORT. BY MAILGRAM DATED 11/02/2004, THE FEC SENT YOU NOTIFICATION OF THE RTB FINDING THAT INCLUDED A CIVIL MONEY PENALTY CALCULATED AT THE RTB STAGE OF \$4500 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE OF PENALTIES AT 11 C.F.R. 111.43. ON 12/15/2004, THE FEC RECEIVED PAYMENT OF YOUR CIVIL MONEY PENALTY CALCULATED AT THE RTB STAGE.
