SUBJECT: REASON TO BELIEVE RECOMMENDATION – 2010 OCTOBER
QUARTERLY REPORT (NON-ELECTION SENSITIVE) FOR THE
ADMINISTRATIVE FINE PROGRAM

Attached is a list of political committees and their treasurers who failed to file the 2010 October Quarterly Report in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434(a). The October Quarterly Report was due on October 15, 2010.

The committees listed in the attached RTB Circulation Report either failed to file the report, filed the report more than five (5) days after the due date, or filed the report more than thirty (30) days after the due date (considered a non-filed report). In accordance with the schedule of civil money penalties for reports at 11 CFR 111.43, these committees should be assessed the civil money penalties highlighted on the attached circulation report.

Recommendation

1. Find reason to believe that the political committees and their treasurers listed on the RTB Circulation Report violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a) and make a preliminary determination that the civil money penalties would be the amounts indicated on the RTB Circulation Report.
2. Send the appropriate letters.

Dear Mr. Skilton:

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires that your committee file an October Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements every calendar year. This report, covering the period through September 30th, shall be filed no later than October 15th. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a). Records at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") indicate that this report was not filed within thirty (30) days of the due date. You should file this report if you have not already done so.

The Act permits the FEC to impose civil money penalties for violations of the reporting requirements of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a). 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4). On December 15, 2010, the FEC found that there is reason to believe ("RTB") that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) by failing to file timely this report on or before October 15th.

Based on the FEC's schedules of civil money penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43, the amount of your civil money penalty calculated at the RTB stage is \$2,970. Please see the attached copy of the Commission's administrative fine regulations at 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.30-111.46. Attachment 1. The Commission's website contains further information about how the administrative fine program works and how the fines are calculated. See <http://www.fec.gov/af/af.shtml>. 11 C.F.R. § 111.34. Your payment of \$2,970 is due within forty (40) days of the finding, or by January 24, 2011, and is based on these factors:

Sensitivity of Report: Not Election Sensitive
Level of Activity: \$67,682
Number of Days Late: Not Filed
Number of Previous Civil Money Penalties Assessed: 0

At this juncture, the following courses of action are available to you:

1. If You Choose to Challenge the RTB Finding and/or Civil Money Penalty

If you should decide to challenge the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, you must submit a written response, including the AF# found at the top of page 1 under your committee's identification number, to the FEC's Office of Administrative Review, 999 E Street,

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NW, Washington, DC 20463. Your response must be received within forty (40) days of the Commission's RTB finding, or January 24, 2011. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(a). Your written response must include the reason(s) why you are challenging the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, and must include the factual basis supporting the reason(s) and supporting documentation. The FEC strongly encourages that documents be submitted in the form of affidavits or declarations. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(c).

The FEC will only consider challenges that are based on at least one of three grounds: (1) a factual error in the RTB finding; (2) miscalculation of the calculated civil money penalty by the FEC; or (3) your demonstrated use of best efforts to file in a timely manner when prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond your control. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). In order for a challenge to be considered on the basis of best efforts, you must have filed the required report no later than 24 hours after the end of these reasonably unforeseen circumstances. *Id.* Examples of circumstances that will be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond your control include, but are not limited to, (1) a failure of Commission computers or Commission-provided software despite your seeking technical assistance from Commission personnel and resources; (2) a widespread disruption of information transmissions over the Internet that is not caused by a failure of the Commission's or your computer systems or Internet service provider; and (3) severe weather or other disaster-related incident. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(c). Examples of circumstances that will not be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond your control include, but are not limited to, (1) negligence; (2) delays caused by vendors or contractors; (3) treasurer and staff illness, inexperience or unavailability; (4) committee computer, software, or Internet service provider failures; (5) failure to know filing dates; and (6) failure to use filing software properly. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(d).

The "failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver" of your right to present such argument in a petition to the U.S. district court under 2 U.S.C. § 437g. 11 C.F.R. § 111.38.

If you intend to be represented by counsel, please advise the Office of Administrative Review. You should provide, in writing, the name, address and telephone number of your counsel and authorize counsel to receive notifications and communications relating to this challenge and imposition of the calculated civil money penalty.

2. If You Choose Not to Pay the Civil Money Penalty and Not to Submit a Challenge

If you do not pay the calculated civil money penalty and do not submit a written response, the FEC will assume that the preceding factual allegations are true and make a final determination that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty.

Unpaid civil money penalties assessed through the Administrative Fine regulations will be subject to the Debt Collection Act of 1982 ("DCA"), as amended by the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996, 31 U.S.C. § 3701 *et seq.* The FEC may take any and all appropriate action authorized and required by the DCA, as amended, including transfer to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection. 11 C.F.R. § 111.51(a)(2).


3. If You Choose to Pay the Civil Money Penalty

If you should decide to pay the calculated civil money penalty, send the enclosed remittance form, along with your payment, to the FEC at the address on page 4. Upon receipt of your payment, the FEC will send you a final determination letter.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the FEC in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2). It will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A) until it is placed on the public record in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.42, unless you notify the FEC in writing that you wish the matter to be made public.



Gentlemen:

Attached are copies of the two FEC Reports for both October and December. These reports were filed electronically. We misunderstood that, since the candidate withdrew from the campaign when he lost the nomination by his party in May 2010, the remaining reports were not required. However, we learned that this was not correct later in 2010. We may have been a little late for the October Filing, but both of these reports were filed electronically last year. We ask that you forgive the financial penalty. Thank you.

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires that your committee file an October Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements every calendar year. This report, covering the period through September 30th, shall be filed no later than October 15th. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a). Records at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") indicate that this report was not filed within thirty (30) days of the due date. You should file this report if you have not already done so.

1. If You Choose to Challenge the RTB Finding and/or Civil Money Penalty

NW, Washington, DC 20463. Your response must be received within forty (40) days of the Commission's RTB finding, or January 24, 2011. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(a). Your written response must include the reason(s) why you are challenging the RTB finding and/or calculated civil money penalty, and must include the factual basis supporting the reason(s) and supporting documentation. The FEC strongly encourages that documents be submitted in the form of affidavits or declarations. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(o).

The FEC will only consider challenges that are based on at least one of three grounds: (1) a factual error in the RTB finding; (2) miscalculation of the calculated civil money penalty by the FEC; or (3) your demonstrated use of best efforts to file in a timely manner when prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond your control. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). In order for a challenge to be considered on the basis of best efforts, you must have filed the required report no later than 24 hours after the end of these reasonably unforeseen circumstances. *Id.* Examples of circumstances that will be considered reasonably unforeseen and beyond your control include, but are not limited to, (1) a failure of Commission computers or Commission-provided software despite your seeking technical assistance from Commission personnel and resources; (2) a widespread disruption of information transmissions over the Internet that is not caused by a failure of the Commission's or your computer systems or Internet service provider; and (3) severe weather or other disaster-related incident. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(c). The "failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver" of your right to present such argument in a petition to the U.S. district court under 2 U.S.C. § 437g. 11 C.F.R. § 111.38.

If you intend to be represented by counsel, please advise the Office of Administrative Review. You should provide, in writing, the name, address and telephone number of your counsel and authorize counsel to receive notifications and communications relating to this challenge and imposition of the calculated civil money penalty.

If you do not pay the calculated civil money penalty and do not submit a written response, the FEC will assume that the preceding factual allegations are true and make a final determination that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty.





Summary of Recommendation

Make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a \$550 civil money penalty.

Reason-to-Believe Background

On December 15, 2010, the Commission found reason to believe ("RTB") that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2010 October Quarterly Report and made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$2,970 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. A letter was mailed to the respondents' address of record from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on December 21, 2010 to notify them of the Commission's RTB finding and civil money penalty.

Legal Requirements

The Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act") states that the treasurer of a principal campaign committee of a candidate shall file a report for the period ending September 30 no later than October 15. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(a)(1)(i). Reports electronically filed must be received and validated at or before 11:59 pm Eastern Standard/Daylight Time on October 15 to be timely filed. 11 C.F.R. §§ 100.19(c) and 104.5(e). The treasurer shall be personally responsible for the timely filing of reports. 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d).

Respondents' Challenge

On January 18, 2011, the Commission received the written response ("challenge") from the Treasurer requesting that the Commission forgive the financial penalty. Since the Candidate withdrew from the campaign following his failure to secure his party's nomination in May 2010, it was thought that the remaining reports were not required. The October Quarterly Report has since been filed and the respondents paid the RTB civil money penalty on January 24, 2011. Included with the challenge is a copy of the RTB letter, and copies of the October Quarterly and Year End Reports.

Analysis

Because the respondents did not file a Termination Report on or before October 15, 2010, indicating that: the Committee will no longer receive contributions or make disbursements; that there are no outstanding debts or obligations; and the purpose for which any residual funds will

be used, they were required to file the October Quarterly Report. 11 C.F.R. § 102.3 and 2 U.S.C. § 433(d)(1). The respondents were notified of this filing requirement, as well as the due date of the report, before and after the filing deadline. On September 21, 2010, the Commission sent the Prior Notice for the 2010 October Quarterly Report to "KLW@WADEFORDELAWARE.COM," the email address listed on their Statement of Organization. Additionally, on November 4, 2010, the Commission sent them a non-filer notice at their address of record, the same address to which the RTB letter was sent and received by the respondents.

There are four criteria used to calculate the civil money penalty. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. They are: the election sensitivity of a report, the number of prior violations, the number of days late, and the level of activity on the late report. The October Quarterly Report was not an election sensitive report and the respondents have no prior violations. The Commission did not file the October Quarterly Report before the RTB finding, therefore an estimated level of activity (\$67,682) was used to calculate the fine. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(d)(2)(i). The report was filed on December 31 and is considered not filed for purposes of the civil money penalty calculation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(e)(1). Their report discloses \$12,142 in receipts and \$250 in disbursements, resulting in an actual level of activity of \$12,392. Therefore, using the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(a) and the level of activity bracket of \$10,000 - \$24,999.99, the civil money penalty is $\$550 \times [1 + (.25 \times 0)]$ or \$550, reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$2,970.

Their challenge fails to address any of the three valid grounds at 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b). These are: (i) the RTB finding is based on factual errors; and/or (ii) the improper calculation of the civil money penalty; and/or (iii) they used best efforts to file on time but were prevented from doing so by reasonably unforeseen circumstances that were beyond their control and they filed the report no later than 24 hours after the end of these circumstances. Therefore, the Reviewing Officer recommends that the Commission make a final determination that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and assess a civil money penalty of \$550. If the Commission votes to uphold the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, \$2,420 will be refunded to the respondents.

OAR Recommendations

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 2252 involving Wade for Delaware and Harry Skilton, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 2252 that Wade for Delaware and Harry Skilton, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a), and based on the actual level of activity disclosed on the October Quarterly Report (\$12,392), assess a civil money penalty of \$550 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$2,970); and
- (3) Send the appropriate letter.



On December 15, 2010, the Commission found reason to believe ("RTB") that the respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2010 October Quarterly Report. As a result, the Commission also made a preliminary determination that the civil money penalty was \$2,970 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43.

On December 31, 2010, the respondents filed the October Quarterly Report, and disclosed \$12,142 in total receipts and \$250 in total disbursements. Had the report been filed disclosing this level of activity (\$12,392) prior to the Commission's RTB finding, the civil money penalty would have been \$550 based on the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43(a).

On January 18, 2011, the Commission received the respondents' written response ("challenge"). After reviewing the challenge, the Reviewing Officer's recommendation dated March 18, 2011 was forwarded to the Commission, a copy was sent to the respondents, and is hereby incorporated by reference. The Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission make a final determination that they violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and based on the actual level of activity for the October Quarterly reporting period (\$12,392), assess a civil money penalty of \$550 because they submitted no evidence that a factual error was made in the RTB finding, that the penalty was miscalculated at RTB or that they used best efforts to file on time. 11 C.F.R. § 111.35(b).

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The \$2,970 civil money penalty calculated at RTB was received at the Commission's lockbox on January 24, 2011; therefore, if the Commission votes to uphold the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, \$2,420 will be refunded to the respondents.

Within 10 days of transmittal of the recommendation, the respondents may file a written response with the Commission Secretary which may not raise any arguments not raised in the respondents' challenge or not directly responsive to the Reviewing Officer's recommendation. 11 C.F.R. § 111.36(f). As of this date, a written response has not been received.

OAR Recommendations

- (1) Adopt the Reviewing Officer recommendation for AF# 2252 involving Wade for Delaware and Harry Skilton, in his official capacity as Treasurer, in making the final determination;
- (2) Make a final determination in AF# 2252 that Wade for Delaware and Harry Skilton, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a), and based on the actual level of activity disclosed on the October Quarterly Report (\$12,392), assess a civil money penalty of \$550 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$2,970); and
- (3) Send the appropriate letter.

On December 15, 2010, the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission" found reason to believe that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) for failing to file the 2010 October Quarterly Report. By letter dated December 21, 2010, the Commission sent you notification of the RTB finding that included a civil money penalty calculated at RTB of \$2,970 in accordance with the schedule of penalties at 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. On January 18, 2011, the Office of Administrative Review received the written response from you challenging the RTB finding. On January 24, the Commission received your \$2,970 payment.

The Reviewing Officer reviewed the Commission's RTB finding with its supporting documentation and your written response. Based on this review, the Reviewing Officer recommended that the Commission reduce the RTB civil money penalty because it was calculated on an estimated level of activity, make a final determination that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and, based on the actual level of activity disclosed on the October Quarterly Report filed December 31, 2010 (\$12,392), assess a civil money penalty in the amount of \$550 in accordance with 11 C.F.R. § 111.43. The basis for the Reviewing Officer's recommendation was included in the Final Determination Report, a copy of which was sent to you on March 21, 2011.

On April 20, 2011, the Commission adopted the Reviewing Officer's recommendation, made a final determination that Wade for Delaware and you, in your official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) and based on the level of activity disclosed on the 2010 October Quarterly Report (\$12,392), assessed a civil money penalty of \$550 (reduced from the RTB civil money penalty of \$2,970). It is based on the same factors used to calculate the civil money penalty at RTB except that the actual rather than the estimated level of activity was used.

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A copy of the final determination memorandum is attached. A refund of \$2,420 will be processed and returned to you.

If You Choose to Appeal the Final Determination and/or Civil Money Penalty

If you choose to appeal the final determination, you should submit a written petition, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, to the district court of the United States for the district in which the committee or treasurer reside, or transact business, requesting that the final determination be modified or set aside. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(C)(iii). Your failure to raise an argument in a timely fashion during the administrative process shall be deemed a waiver of the respondents' right to present such argument in a petition to the district court under 2 U.S.C. § 437g. 11 C.F.R. § 111.38.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. The file will be made a part of the public record pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 111.42(b). Although the file must be placed on the public record within 30 days from the date of the Commission's notification, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote.
