The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 21L-11 for processing on March 24, 2021, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1003. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred American Freedom Fund and Bill Jones, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$50,000 to support one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2020 12-Day Pre-General Report.

In a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) filed on January 27, 2021, the Committee stated it misunderstood that the 48-Hour Report was required in addition to the 12-Day Pre-General Report. The Committee further noted that the 48-Hour Report has been filed, albeit untimely, and that it now understands the 48-Hour Report rules and reporting responsibilities. In addition, the Committee notes that it has installed procedures to ensure that additional reports are not missed.
