III. BACKGROUND:

**Excessive, Prohibited and Other Impermissible Contributions (Failure to Refund, Redesignate, or Reattribute Excessive and Prohibited Contributions within the Permissible Timeframe)**

Hickenlooper for Colorado (“the Committee”) received excessive and prohibited contributions totaling \$26,000.00 for the 2020 Primary and General Elections from fourteen (14) individuals and one (1) limited liability company (“LLC”). The Committee has refunded these contributions outside of the permissible timeframe (Attachment 2).

2019 Year-End Report

During the 2019 Year-End reporting period, October 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019, the Committee received excessive contributions totaling \$20,500.00 from eleven (11) individuals and a prohibited contribution of \$1,500.00 from one (1) LLC that were not refunded, reattributed, or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Image 202001319184773641, Attachment 2).

On March 19, 2020, a Request for Additional Information (“RFAI”) referencing the 2019 Year-End Report was sent to the Committee. The RFAI noted the Committee’s receipt of apparent excessive and prohibited contributions, among other items, and requested the Committee refund, reattribute, or redesignate the contributions (Image 202003190300061623).

On April 23, 2020, the Committee filed an FEC Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) in response to the RFAI refencing the 2019 Year-End Report. The Committee stated in part:

“This is in response to your letter dated March 19, 2020 concerning the Year-End Report (10/01/2019 – 12/31/2019) for Hickenlooper for Colorado (the “Committee”).

1. Committee had already identified all contributions that were over the limits by the time it filed its 2019 Year-End Report and noted on the report where it was making refunds. Due to duplicate records in Committee’s database, some allocations were incorrect on the report, and Committee is now filing an amended report to show correct allocations for each impacted individual. All refunds appear on Committee’s 2020 April Quarterly Report...
2. After conducting a reasonable inquiry into the donors’ nationalities...Due to lack of response, we have refunded Deborah Rohan’s contribution. Committee’s amendment discloses clarifying information for both contributions, and Committee’s 2020 July Quarterly Report will disclose the refund to Deborah Rohan.
3. Terra Linda LLC did not respond to our efforts to determine partnership allocations, so we have refunded the contribution. Committee’s amendment discloses clarifying information, and Committee’s 2020 April Quarterly Report discloses the refund...” (Image 202004239232291980).

On July 7, 2020, the Committee filed two Amended 2019 Year-End Reports (Images 202007079244340756 and 202007079244344489). The amendments provided corrections for data entry errors as indicated in the Committee’s April 23, 2020 FEC Form 99.

#### 2020 April Quarterly Report

During the 2020 April Quarterly reporting period, January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020, the Committee received excessive contributions totaling \$4,000.00 from three (3) individuals that were not refunded, reattributed, or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Image 202004159219220508, Attachment 2).

On June 2, 2020, an RFAI referencing the 2020 April Quarterly Report was sent to the Committee. The RFAI noted the Committee's receipt of apparent excessive contributions, among other issues, and requested that the Committee refund, reattribute or redesignate these contributions (Image 202006020300073373).

On June 15, 2021, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") Analyst contacted Lili Snyder, a Compliance Assistant for the Committee, and mentioned that the Committee may be referred to another Commission office due to the excessive contributions that were remedied outside of the permissible timeframe. The Analyst noted all of the excessive contributions in question had been remedied. Further, the Analyst mentioned the office conducting the review would be in touch but the Committee could contact the Analyst should they have any questions. Ms. Snyder stated she understood and would notify her colleagues (Attachment 3).

On June 24, 2021, the RAD Analyst called Lauren Lee, a Compliance Specialist affiliated with the Committee. The RAD Analyst informed her the Committee would be referred for further review to another Commission office due to excessive and prohibited contributions not remedied within the permissible timeframe. Ms. Lee and the Analyst discussed the reports in question, and the Analyst noted the Committee remedied all the transactions in question. Ms. Lee agreed to do additional research and, if needed, provide clarifying information (Attachment 3).

On July 7, 2020, the Committee filed an Amended 2020 April Quarterly Report and an FEC Form 99 in response to the RFAI referencing the 2020 April Quarterly Report (Image 202007079244346813). The FEC Form 99 stated, in part:

"...The Committee had already identified many of the referenced contributions as over the limits by the time it filed its 2020 April Quarterly Report and noted on the report where it was making refunds. Those refunds will be on the Committee's Pre-Primary Report. Due to duplicate records in the Committee's database, some allocations were incorrect on the April Quarterly Report. The Committee has corrected its database, issued refunds if necessary (which appear on the Pre-Primary Report), and has also filed an amended April Quarterly Report to show correct allocations..." (Image 202007079244356471).

On July 14, 2021, Ms. Lee contacted the RAD Analyst. Among other issues, Ms. Lee inquired about the Committee's pending referral to another Commission office concerning the excessive and prohibited contributions (Attachment 3).

To date, no further communications have been received from the Committee regarding this matter.
