I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on June 23, 2022, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Formally transfer Finding 5 to the Office of General Counsel for further processing.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively voted for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Direct the head of Alternative Dispute Resolution Office to notify the 21st Century Democrats, via email, of the option to terminate the audit and enter the Alternative Dispute Resolution process immediately.
- b. Direct Audit to formally transfer interim Findings 1 – 4 to Alternative Dispute Resolution Office for further processing, if a signed commitment to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution process is received within two weeks of notification.
- c. If 21st Century Democrats declines to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution process, Findings 1 – 4 will remain with Audit.
