The Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission (FEC or Commission) is processing an audit of the 21st Century Democrats and Bill Combs, Treasurer (Respondents) for the 2017-2018 election cycle. By vote on June 23, 2022, the Commission authorized the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office to notify you of the option to terminate the audit and enter the Alternative Dispute Resolution process immediately to resolve identified violations in Findings 1-4 of the Interim Audit Report.

The ADR Program provides Respondents with an opportunity to negotiate a mutually agreeable settlement of the matter. If negotiations are successful, the resulting settlement, as approved by the Commission, concludes the matter.

If Respondents elect to participate in ADR processing, you must return the enclosed Commitment to Participate in ADR form electronically to the email below by July 11, 2022. Failure to respond by July 11, 2022, will be taken as notice of disinterest in the program. In the event you do not commit to participate in ADR by this deadline, the audit will continue.
