The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 23L-06 for processing on March 7, 2023, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1101. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

**Summary of Case:** The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred True Democrats Only PAC and Brandon Philipczyk, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file three (3) 48-Hour Reports totaling \$63,517.50 to support six (6) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2022 12-Day Pre-Primary Report. On November 7, 2022, the Committee filed three (3) 48-Hour Reports to support these six (6) independent expenditures, albeit untimely.

**Discussion** (*for internal use only*): ADR can provide an opportunity to utilize corrective measures to encourage future compliance with the FECA. Moreover, the flexibility and informality of the ADR process allows the parties, through joint problem-solving, to fashion specific corrective measures tailored to Respondents, their resources, and the issues involved in the case. Respondents are often more willing to develop creative
