The Alternative Dispute Resolution Office ("ADRO") at the Federal Election Commission received the Designation of Counsel from the Conservative Leadership PAC and David Fenner, Treasurer ("Respondents"). Enclosed please find a copy of the letter sent to Respondents on March 5, 2004, the referral from the Reports Analysis Division, a Commitment to Submit Matter to ADR and a brochure about the ADR process. If Respondents wish to have their case processed through the ADRO, please complete and sign the enclosed form and return it to FEC. If the ADRO does not receive a Commitment from Respondents within **ten business days**, the matter will be returned to the Office of General Counsel for enforcement action. It should be noted that if Respondents do not affirmatively indicate agreement to have the case processed through ADR, the likelihood that the committee will be audited during the next election cycle will increase.
