Dear Mr. Barker:

I have enclosed the agreement following our discussion of earlier today that upon your signature and approval by the Commission will conclude the matter that was first brought to your attention in my letter of July 9, 2004. As you will recall, that earlier letter advised you that a review by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) of the reports filed by the Committee to Elect John Barker with the Federal Election Commission (FEC) warranted further examination for possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (the Act) as amended. The enclosed agreement addresses those issues and reflects the terms discussed earlier today.

If the enclosed agreement is acceptable, please sign it and return it to this office with your check made payable to the US Treasury in the amount of \$500. The signed agreement will be thereafter forwarded to the Commission for its review and approval. After the Commission has approved the agreement, a signed copy will be returned to you for your files and retention.

If you have any questions about the enclosed please be in touch. In the meantime, I also have enclosed an excerpt from a recent FEC press release relating to the issues under discussion that may be of interest to you.

I also recommend that you consider terminating the Committee to Elect John Barker. It will conclude the Committee's reporting responsibilities and prevent other matters from arising that may be in violation of the Act. If you later decide to run again for Congress you can re-register with the Commission and have the benefit of knowing FEC procedures and campaign requirements.

I appreciate your assistance in bringing this matter to a conclusion and look forward to hearing from you.
