Thank you for your letter of June 13, 2005 regarding the complaint that has been filed against the Friend of Greg Parke Committee and you as Treasurer.


I have enclosed a copy of the Commission's letter of July 1, 2004, addressed to you, which contained a copy of the complaint. I also have enclosed a duplicate copy of the complaint and documents that accompanied it.

As noted in my letter of June 8, 2005, the Commission received no reply to its letter of July 1, 2004. Nevertheless, the Commission determined that this matter should be pursued for possible violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971. It is for that reason that the matter was assigned to the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Office for resolution.

If after reviewing the material, the Committee would like the case identified for ADR processing, you should affirmatively indicate that desire on the ADR Commitment form that accompanied my letter of June 8<sup>th</sup>. Failure to respond affirmatively within fifteen days of receipt of this letter will be taken as a notice of disinterest in the ADR program and your case will be returned to the Commission's Office of General Counsel for processing.
