The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 09L-28 for processing on July 27, 2009, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 506. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 506 on August 7, 2009. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Friends of Phil Steck and Cornelius D. Murray, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for a failure to disclose all financial activity on their 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report and their 2008 October Quarterly Report. The Committee filed a 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report on August 28, 2008. The Committee filed several amended 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Reports beginning on October 25, 2008, which resulted in additional disbursements of \$94,987.16. The Committee filed a 2008 October Quarterly Report on October 15, 2008. The Committee filed several amended 2008 October Quarterly Reports beginning on December 29, 2008, which resulted in additional disbursements of \$92,706. Respondents replied to inquiries from RAD that the omissions in disbursements on both reports resulted from overlooked or incorrect entries in disbursements.
