I am Scott Cross the CEO of Temperature Control Systems, Inc. and I am responding today in regards to the above mention subject MUR 6787. I with much embarrassment must admit that on December 23, 2013 authorized a check in the sum of \$5000 to be issue to John Stacy for Texas. John Stacy is a personal friend and I was just trying to help him in his campaign. It is obvious now that we both made what I would characterize as a rookie mistake. Since I have never made a political contribution I was not aware that this transaction was a violation of The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971. John Stacy has never run for a federal office and admitted to me that he too committed a rookie mistake by accepting this contribution. On March 12, 2014 after receiving notice from the Federal Election Committee John Stacy for Texas issued Temperature Control System a check in the sum of \$5000 to return the money given and received in error. I would hope that in consideration of my explanation and the fact that John Stacy for Texas reported this on his Schedule A Itemized Receipts will recognize that this transaction though a violation was a "ROOKIE MISTAKE" on both parties. I appreciate your time and consideration and the learning experience this has been.
