The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 17L-08 for processing on April 10, 2017, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 824. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 824 on April 21, 2017. Summary of Case: RAD referred the Int'l Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers PAC and Timothy J. Driscoll, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file two (2) 48-Hour Reports totaling \$30,140.42 to support twelve (12) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2016 October Monthly Report.

Respondents filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (FEC Form 99) on January 14, 2017 which stated, in part, that the Committee may have "inadvertently and unintentionally missed two 48-Hour Reports, on 09/09/2016 and 09/17/2016." The Committee went on to state that steps have been taken to ensure timely reporting in the future.
