The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 19L-32 for processing on September 12, 2019, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 934. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred the Oklahoma Democratic Party and Rachael Hunsucker, Treasurer, (Respondents or the Committee) for a series of reporting errors and other FECA violations during the 2017-2018 election cycle. A political committee may be referred if, after an internal review of reports filed by the committee, the Commission determines the reports do not meet the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the FECA. The Committee's errors included, among other items: mathematical discrepancies, failure to provide supporting schedules, failure to properly itemize disbursements, Federal Election Activity/Levin Funds, and allocated federal and non-federal activity.
