This refers to your request for an advisory opinion concerning application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, to your campaign committee's purchase of office and fundraising services from a corporation in which you own a partial interest.

Enclosed is a copy of Agenda Document #87-18, which the Office of General Counsel submitted as a proposed response to your request, and Agenda Document 87-18-A, which was submitted by Commissioner Josefiak. On February 26, 1987, the Commission considered these documents, voted on two separate motions, but failed to adopt either proposal by the required affirmative vote of four members of the Commission. 2 U.S.C. §437c(c).

Accordingly, pursuant to Commission regulations at 11 CFR 112.4(a), you are hereby advised that with this letter the Commission has concluded its consideration of AOR 1986-43, your request for an advisory opinion.
