Dear Ms. Gibson:

This refers to your June 30, 1988 letter requesting an advisory opinion on behalf of First Florida Partners for Good Government and First Florida Banks, Inc., concerning application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations to proposed articles in a corporate publication distributed to all employees.

Enclosed are Agenda Documents #88-85 and #88-85-A, which were considered by the Commission on August 11, 1988. On August 11 the Commission failed to approve any of the proposals by the required affirmative vote of four members. 2 U.S.C. §437c(c). The vote on Alternative A of Agenda Document #88-85 was 3-3, and the vote on Alternative B was 2 affirmative and 4 negative. Agenda Document #88-85-A was discussed but not voted upon.

Accordingly, pursuant to Commission regulations at 11 CFR 112.4(a), you are hereby advised that with this letter the Commission has concluded its consideration of Advisory Opinion Request 1988-30.
