Dear Ms. Yarbrough:

This refers to your letters dated September 26 and October 3, 1989 requesting an advisory opinion on behalf of First Florida Partners for Good Government and First Florida Banks, Inc., concerning application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations to the wearing of a pin promoting the PAC.

Enclosed are Agenda Documents #89-98 and #89-98-A, which were considered by the Commission on November 16. On November 16 the Commission failed to approve either of the proposals by the required affirmative vote of four members. 2 U.S.C. §437c(c). The vote on Agenda Document #89-98 was 2 in favor, 4 opposed. Agenda Document #89-98-A was discussed but not voted upon.

Accordingly, pursuant to Commission regulations at 11 CFR 112.4(a), you are hereby advised that with this letter the Commission has concluded its consideration of Advisory Opinion Request 1989-24.
