Dear Commissioners:

Our client, Glaxo Inc., hereby withdraws its request for an advisory opinion (1988-70) that we submitted on its behalf on February 19, 1988. Glaxo decided to withdraw because the Office of General Counsel's recommendation to the Commission did not fully and adequately reflect the facts as set forth in its request. In particular, the recommendation concluded in "Alternative A" that the field representatives whom Glaxo seeks to solicit for contributions to its Separate Segregated Fund were "outside salesmen" under the Fair Labor Standards Act without considering the Wage and Hour Division's (of the Department of Labor) interpretation of "sales."
