Dear Mr. Litchfield:

As we discussed over the telephone this morning, the Ezzard for U.S. Senate Committee, Inc. (the "Committee") desires to formally withdraw, by means of this letter, its request for the above-referenced advisory opinion, pertaining to the reporting of information as to the purchaser of stock contributed to the campaign, pursuant to 11 C.F.R. Section 104.13(b). As we discussed, in light of the fact that this issue has not been definitively decided, the contributor decided to sell the stock individually and contribute the cash proceeds instead of contributing the stock. Accordingly, as there is no longer an actual existing situation, the issue is now moot for the Committee.

I understand that, promptly upon your receipt of this written notice of withdrawal of the above-referenced request, you will delete this matter from the hearing schedule for next Thursday, February 20, 1986. I also understand that you will forward to me a letter confirming the withdrawal of this request, as well as information as to the Federal Election Commission's informal views on this issue, for my future information.

I have received your letter dated February 14, 1986, which indicates your withdrawal of the subject advisory opinion request.


