Dear Mr. Litchfield:

This is in response to the Commission's request for supplemental information from my client, Voter.com, Inc. ("Voter.com") with regard to Advisory Opinion Request 2000-9 submitted to the Commission on May 2, 2000 (the "AOR").

Voter.com has experienced dramatic growth and change since the AOR was submitted. Since that time, Voter.com's political portal website has been completely overhauled and upgraded. For example, Version 3.0 of the website was released in late June.

In addition, the company is rapidly developing a series of new web-based products and services. The process of finalizing these products is in various stages of development. Thus, a comprehensive response to your request for supplemental information is not available at the moment and may not be completed in sufficient time for the Commission to review and respond to the AOR prior to the November, 2000 election.

Accordingly, and for the above-stated reasons, my client has determined to withdraw the AOR at this time.
