1. Failed in a vote of 3-3 to pass a motion to approve draft Advisory Opinion 1994-4, as submitted in Agenda Document #94-63 and amended by Agenda Document #94-63-A.

Commissioners McDonald, McGarry, and Thomas voted affirmatively for the motion; Commissioners Aikens, Elliott, and Potter dissented.

2. Failed in a vote of 3-3 to pass a motion to return draft Advisory Opinion 1994-4 to the General Counsel's Office to be amended to show that there is sufficient organizational attachment to qualify those persons the Chamber considers to be their members, to be communicated with and solicited.

Commissioners Aikens, Elliott, and Potter voted affirmatively for the motion; and Commissioners McDonald, McGarry, and Thomas dissented.
