Dear Commissioner;

I am aware that you have removed an exemption to a 1971 law and will now require that the Socialist Worker's Party disclose the names of financial contributors to its election campaigns. There is no justification for your action against the S.W.P.'s right to participate in elections free from government intimidation. The whole history of the government's disruption campaign against that party points to the need for such an exemption.

The fraud and corruption that prompted the Federal Election Campaign Act in the first place was a phenomenon of the major political parties and not third parties such as the Socialist Workers. Reinstate their exemption at once.
