

GENERATION OF MATTER

On October 23, 1979, the Jon Lindsay Campaign (the Lindsay Committee) was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) for failure to register and report as a political committee, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434.

EVIDENCE

The Lindsay Committee is a state campaign committee. As reported by the Harris County Republican Executive Committee (the County Committee), a federal committee, the Lindsay Committee transferred a total of \$3,774.26 to the County Committee during 1978.

On July 19, 1979, a surface violation letter was sent to the Lindsay Committee informing them that these transfers indicated that they might be a political committee under the Act. As no response was received, the Commission found reason to believe, on September 14, 1979, that the Lindsay Committee may be in violation of 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434.

This prompted a reply by phone and letter from Tony Lindsay, treasurer of the Lindsay Committee, who explained that she did not receive the Commission's first letter. She further stated that the payments made to the County Committee were as follows:

3/13/78	\$149.20	normal charge for lists of primary voters
4/11/78	\$200.00	normal charge for ad in newspaper
9/6/78	\$1,757.56	pro-rata share of cost for walk lists

10/23/78

\$1,667.50

pro-rata share of cost for
voters guide

With her letter, Ms. Lindsay included a copy of a letter to her from the treasurer of the Harris County Republican Party. This letter confirmed that these charges were the "normal" charges for these items.

PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS

In AO 1979-18, the Commission provided that the sale of a membership list could involve the receipt of a contribution from a purchaser of the list if the purchase price exceeded the usual and normal charge for such a list in the market from which it would ordinarily be purchased.^{1/} See §100.4(a)(1)(iii)(B).

Here it has been stated that the Lindsay Committee paid the normal charge for all services rendered by the County Committee. Therefore, no contributions were made by the Lindsay Committee which would trigger the registration and reporting requirements of the Act.

In view of this fact, the Office of General Counsel recommends the Commission find no reasonable cause to believe the Lindsay Committee has violated 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find no reasonable cause to believe the Lindsay Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434.
2. Send the attached letter.
3. Close the file.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act. Our review of the receipts reported by Harris County Republican Executive Committee indicates that your organization may have made contributions which total in excess of \$1,000 during the calendar year. Enclosed is a copy(s) of the report(s) in which your contribution(s) is listed.

The Act defines "political committee" to mean any organization, or other group of persons which receives contributions or makes expenditures (which includes contributions to Federal candidates and committees supporting Federal candidates), aggregating in excess of \$1,000 during a calendar year. It would appear that your organization may qualify as a "political committee" subject to registration, reporting, and contribution limitation requirements of the Act.

If you agree that your organization is a political committee, please submit a Statement of Organization on FEC Form 1, in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 433. In addition, your committee will be required to file disclosure reports in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434 on FEC Form 3.

If you agree that your organization has made contributions or expenditures which qualify you as a "political committee", but you do not wish to be considered as a "political committee", you must request refund(s) from the candidate(s) and/or political committee(s) to which you have contributed. As an alternative, political committees to which you made contributions may transfer all or part of the contributions to accounts which are not used to influence Federal elections. Refunds or transfers must be made in such amounts that the total remaining contributions made by you do not exceed \$1,000 during a calendar year.

If you believe that your organization is not a political committee, or that the Commission is otherwise in error, please submit a statement which would clarify this matter for the public record. We have also enclosed relevant informational materials and forms for the registration of and reporting by the political committee. Please examine the enclosed materials.




On July 19, 1979, you were notified that you may have made contributions to a political committee which raised problems under 2 U.S.C. 433 and 434.

Sometime during this past summer a large envelope full of a thick sheaf of FEC reporting forms appeared on my cabinet while I was not at home. My son said the post lady brought it. After searching the inside and the outside of the big envelope for some letter of explanation, and finding none, I could only assume that this was an example of federal waste--since we have not had anything to do with a federal election and are not planning one.

On Sept. 17 I received a letter stating that I had already been notified on July 19 of some problem relating to 2 U.S.C. 433 and 434. I had never seen any such letter and I still don't know what "2 U.S.C. 433 & 434" are, since I have not received the copy which you promised me when I talked with you later that same day.

You questioned me about so-called contributions made by us to the Harris County Republican party during 1978. We did not make any contributions to the Harris County Republican Party during 1978. 4 payments made by us to the party were listed on their report to the FEC--apparently because they are doing their best to make sure they are complying with every conceivable jot & tittle of the law.

This letter is to verify that those payments were what they were represented to be, namely:

3-13-78	\$149.20--we paid the normal charge for lists of primary voters.
4-11-78	\$200.00--we paid the normal charge for an ad in the republican newspaper.
9-6-78	\$1,757.56--we paid a pro-rata share of the cost to the local party to obtain walk lists used by many volunteer party workers.
10-23-78	\$1,667.53--we paid a pro-rata share of the cost to the local party to print a voters guide of republican candidates.

I am also enclosing the letter to us from the Harris County Republican party, requested by you, reiterating that these are the facts.



Sometime during this past summer a large envelope full of a thick sheaf of FEC reporting forms appeared on my cabinet while I was not at home. My son said the post lady brought it. After searching the inside and the outside of the big envelope for some letter of explanation, and finding none, I could only assume that this was an example of federal waste--since we have not had anything to do with a federal election and are not planning one.

On Sept. 17 I received a letter stating that I had already been notified on July 19 of some problem relating to 2 U.S.C. 433 and 434. I had never seen any such letter and I still don't know what "2 U.S.C. 433 & 434" are, since I have not received the copy which you promised me when I talked with you later that same day.

You questioned me about so-called contributions made by us to the Harris County Republican party during 1978. We did not make any contributions to the Harris County Republican Party during 1978. 4 payments made by us to the party were listed on their report to the FEC--apparently because they are doing their best to make sure they are complying with every conceivable jot & tittle of the law.

This letter is to verify that those payments were what they were represented to be, namely:

- 3-13-78 \$149.20--we paid the normal charge for lists of primary voters.
- 4-11-78 \$200.00--we paid the normal charge for an ad in the republican newspaper.
- 9-6-78 \$1,757.56--we paid a pro-rata share of the cost to the local party to obtain walk lists used by many volunteer party workers.
- 10-23-78 \$1,667.50--we paid a pro-rata share of the cost to the local party to print a voters guide of republican candidates.

I am also enclosing the letter to us from the Harris County Republican party, requested by you, reiterating that these are the facts.
