CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that American Security Council Political Action Committee and Joseph L. Rutherford, as treasurer, (hereinafter "the Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i), do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding.

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. American Security Council Political Action Committee is a political committee registered with the Commission.

2. Joseph L. Rutherford is the treasurer of the American Security Council Political Action Committee.

3. The Respondents were required to file a 12 Day Pre-General Election Report on October 25, 1984. Instead, Respondents filed a November Monthly Report on November 23, 1984, disclosing activity for the entire month of October.

4. The November Monthly Report disclosed activity from the pre-general election period (10/1-10/17 1984).

5. On December 17, 1984, Respondents filed the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report with the Commission.

V. Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to timely file the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report, respondents contend that such violation was not knowing and wilful.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the treasurer of the United States in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents will institute procedures to ensure that all Reports of Receipts and Disbursements are filed with the Commission in a timely manner.

VIII. Respondents agree that they shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date all parties hereto have executed the same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.


XI. The Commission on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

XII. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.







**GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT**

**I. BACKGROUND**

On April 8, 1985, the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that The American Security Council Political Action Committee and Joseph L. Rutherford, as its treasurer (hereinafter "ASC-PAC" or "Respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to timely file its 12 Day Pre-General Report.

The General Counsel's

brief recommending probable cause was circulated to the Commission on August 16, 1985, and the Respondent's brief was submitted September 5, 1985.

## II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

For a legal analysis of the Respondents' violations of the Act, the Office of General Counsel relies upon its brief circulated to the Commission on August 16, 1985. Furthermore, Respondents' brief acknowledges their violation of the Act and simply repeats their initial response to the notification of reason to believe. Respondents were under the mistaken assumption that political committees which filed monthly reports were not required to file a 12 Day Pre-General Report. Relying on this belief, Respondents erroneously filed only their regular monthly reports, with their November Report disclosing activity that should have been reported in a 12 Day Pre-General Report.

Respondents' unawareness of the reporting requirements of monthly filers during an election year does not excuse the violation. In the Campaign Guide for non-connected committees, the instructions for monthly filers clearly state:

In lieu of the monthly report due in November...for a year on which there is a "Regular" November General Election, a 12 Day Pre-general Election Report must be filed including all transactions from the closing date of the last report filed through the 20th day before the election...

Further, on October 1, 1984, the Office of Public Information notified all monthly filers that "all committees that file monthly reports must file the pre-general election report due October 15, 1984." Thus, Respondents' had adequate notice of the filing requirements of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the

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
Commission find probable cause to believe that Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

IV. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find probable cause to believe that The American Security Council Political Action Committee and James C. Rutherford, as its treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

2. Approve the attached Conciliation Agreement and letter.

BRIEF OF RESPONDENTS

I. INTRODUCTION

The General Counsel's brief requests that the Commission find probable cause to believe that respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 ("the Act").

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## II. ARGUMENT

### A. Respondents' Violation Was Not Knowing Or Willful

Respondents' fundamental error in this matter was that they believed that political committees which filed monthly were not required to file pre- and post-general election reports in addition to monthly reports. See Exhibit 2, Letter of Treasurer. Relying on this belief, on November 15, 1984, respondents mailed a report to the Commission disclosing all activity for the month of October 1984. See Exhibit 3, Monthly Report for October. Immediately upon being informed that a pre-general election report was required, the treasurer of respondent American Security Council Political Action Committee, Joseph L. Rutherford, compiled such a report and mailed it to the Commission on December 5, 1984.<sup>\*/</sup> See Exhibit 4, Pre-General Election Report.

Respondents consistently have attempted to comply fully with the filing obligations of the Act. As stated by Mr. Rutherford,

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<sup>\*/</sup> According to General Counsel's pleadings, the filing date for the pre-general election report is December 17, 1984. Mr. Rutherford recalls mailing the report on the day it was signed, December 5, 1984. A similarly long period of time elapsed between the time that respondents' monthly report for October was mailed, November 15, 1985, and the date given in General Counsel's pleadings as the filing date for that report, November 23, 1984. It is possible that some part of the eight or twelve days involved in transit time was spent at the FEC rather than in transit. To the extent that this is true, it is unfair to penalize respondents for the delay.



the committee elected to file monthly "even though there was more work involved to insure that the reporting was completed in a timely manner." See Exhibit 2. As soon as respondents were informed of their error, they brought their reports into compliance. This is not a case involving a "non-filer." This is, rather, a case involving a mistake made in an earnest effort to comply with the Act. Respondents now are aware of the full extent of the filing obligations applicable to committees reporting monthly.

Both the Act and the Commission's regulations recognize that in certain circumstances, a treasurer's "best efforts" to comply with the reporting obligations of the Act will be deemed to constitute compliance with the Act. 2 U.S.C. §432(i); 11 CFR §104.7 (1985). These provisions indicate that it is entirely appropriate for the Commission to consider a treasurer's efforts to comply in addition to considering whether those efforts met absolutely the objective requirements of the Act.

The record shows that respondents filed a report disclosing all activity for the month of October. Respondents made their best efforts to comply with the Act. The violation of applicable reporting requirements was not knowing or willful.

B. The Amount At Issue Is Relatively Small

The pre-general election report that was filed by respondents, in response to the Commission's notice that the October monthly

report was in error, covered the period October 1, 1984 through October 17, 1984. Of the committee's expenditures, there were only two contributions to candidates, one for \$250 and one for \$500, for a total of \$750. The purpose of the reporting and disclosure provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act was, first and foremost, to ensure complete disclosure of receipts and expenditures by candidates and their committees. See, e.g., S. Rep. No. 689, 93d Cong., 2d. Sess. 2, reprinted in 1974 U.S. Code Cong. & Ad. News 5587, 5588. The gravity of respondents' error in this regard may be judged by the amount of respondents' contributions to candidates that would have been disclosed prior to the election if respondents had not mistakenly filed a monthly report for October. That amount is \$750.

In considering the constitutionality of the Act's reporting and disclosure requirements in Buckley v. Valeo, 424 U.S. 1, 96 S.Ct. 612 (1976), the Supreme Court reiterated its repeated finding in the past that "compelled disclosure, in itself, can seriously infringe on privacy of association and belief guaranteed by the First Amendment." Id. at 656. The Court held that the Federal Election Campaign Act disclosure provisions were justified by legitimate governmental interests which included providing the electorate with information "as to where political campaign money comes from and how it is spent by the candidate" in order to aid in the evaluation of candidates. Id. at 657. In addition, the

disclosure provisions were justified because they would expose large contributions and expenditures to the light of publicity, thereby enabling the detection of post-election special favors. A third justification for the disclosure provisions was that they would permit the necessary gathering of data to determine whether contribution limitations had been violated. Id. at 658.

The weighty governmental interests which justified the infringement of First Amendment rights that is caused by compelled disclosure were directly related to the public's "need to know" the facts regarding campaign contributions to candidates. This view is confirmed by literature in the field. See e.g., Schwarz & Straus, Federal Regulation of Campaign Finance and Political Activity §1.03[1] (1985) (impetus for Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 provided by dangers of spiraling campaign costs, which included possibility of corruption and undue influence by wealthy interests). In respondents' case, the failure to timely disclose campaign contributions involved a total of \$750, a relatively small amount.


Enclosed please find a copy of the original monthly filing by the American Security Council Political Action Committee for the month of October, 1984.



**GENERAL COUNSEL'S BRIEF**

**I. STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

The American Security Council Political Action Committee (hereinafter "ASC-PAC") and Joseph L. Rutherford, as treasurer, failed to file timely its 12 Day Pre-General Election Report in violation 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). The report was due October 25, 1984, covering the period October 1 through October 17, 1984. A 12 Day Pre-General Election Report was filed by the Respondent on December 17, 1984. Prior to that date, the Respondent filed a November monthly report on November 23, 1984, disclosing activity from 10/1-10/31.

ASC-PAC was sent a prior notice on October 1, 1984, which specifically informed it of the requirement of a 12 Day Pre-General Election Report on October 25, 1984. A non-filer notice was also sent to ASC-PAC on November 16, 1984, due to its failure to file the Pre-General Election Report.

On April 8, 1985, the Commission found reason to believe that ASC-PAC violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

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**LEGAL ANALYSIS**

An authorized committee is required by 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(ii) to file a pre-election report in an election year. The report must be filed no later than the 12th day before any election in which the committee makes any contributions or expenditures on behalf of a candidate in such election.

ASC-PAC did not file its 12 Day Pre-General Election Report on the due date, October 24, 1984. Instead, ASC-PAC filed a November Monthly Report on November 23, 1984, disclosing its activity for the entire month of October. Subsequently, on December 17, 1984, the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report was filed by the Committee.

Since the pre-election report coverage dates (10/1-10/17) were included in the November Monthly Report, the November Monthly Report filing date is the date used to compute the late filing of ASC-PAC's 12 Day Pre-General Election Report. Thus ASC-PAC filed the disclosure of activity for the pre-election time period 29 days late. (The activity attributable to the pre-election period totals \$505.50 in receipts and \$4,600 in expenditures). Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find probable cause to believe that the American Security Council PAC and Joseph Rutherford, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).







In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The American Security Council Political Action Committee (hereinafter "ASC-PAC") and Joseph L. Rutherford, as treasurer, failed to timely file its 12 Day Pre-General Election Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). The report was due October 25, 1984, covering the period October 1 through October 17, 1984. A 12 Day Pre-General Election Report was filed by the Respondent on December 17, 1984. Prior to that date, the Respondent incorrectly filed a November monthly report on November 23, 1984, disclosing activity from 10/1-10/31.

ASC-PAC was sent a prior notice on October 1, 1984 which specifically informed it of the requirement of a 12 Day Pre-General Election Report on October 25, 1984. A non-filer notice was also sent to ASC-PAC on November 16, 1984, due to its failure to file the pre-general election report.

LEGAL AND FACTUAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) requires an unauthorized committee to file, in an election year, a pre-election report. It is required that the report be filed no later than the 12th day before any election in which the committee makes a contribution or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election.

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ASC-PAC did not file its 12 Day Pre-General Election Report on the due date, October 25, 1984. Instead, ASC-PAC filed a November Monthly Report on November 23, 1984, disclosing its activity for the entire month of October. Subsequently, on December 17, 1984 the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report was filed by the Committee.

Since the pre-election report coverage date (10/1-10/17) were included in the coverage dates of the November Monthly Report and activity was disclosed, it is recommended that the November Monthly Report filing date be the date used to compute the late filing of ASC-PAC's 12 Day Pre-General Election Report and the subsequently filed 12 Day Pre-General Election Report.

Therefore, the disclosure of activity for the pre-election time period was filed 29 days late by ASC-PAC. The activity attributable to the pre-election period is \$505.50 in receipts and 4,600 in expenditures.
