SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION

The complainant alleges that the respondent, during the period from March 1974 through May 1976, filed several reports late, failed to file some reports, made several mathematical errors, and omitted the occupations and places of business of some contributors. The reporting errors all involve contributions received and expenditures made during respondent's unsuccessful 1974 Congressional Campaign

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

The attached report submitted by Reports Examining indicates that the respondent is usually a late filer, and makes numerous mathematical errors but has responded fully to all requests for additional information or reports. Accordingly, it appears that, although violations of §434 have been committed, these have now been corrected and the respondent is now in substantial compliance with the Federal Election Campaign Laws.



In particular we note that all of the reporting violations allegedly committed by Dr. Grady have been corrected through amendment of the filing of subsequent reports. This letter is to serve as notice of an official complaint against Dr. John Grady, 300 S. Main, Belle Glade, Florida, (identification number C-453), for a number of apparent violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as Amended.

Each apparent violation listed should be construed as an individual complaint as such.

This series of complaints is being filed on the basis of the following information:

Dr. Grady's first Report was filed on June 10, 1974, before which the Secretary of the Senate on June 10, 1974. It was received by the Secretary of the Senate on June 22, 1974, and was appropriately marked "Late Filing." Dr. Grady marked on this Report a certification that he had not received any receipts, nor made any expenditures for that reporting period. However, this the Secretary of the Senate advised that he did not believe in the certification of the law which allows for late filing, and the intention of the law was to allow the public to see a timely report of receipts and expenditures.

Dr. Grady then filed a June 10, 1974, Report, which was received by the Secretary of the Senate on June 10, 1974, and was received by the Secretary of the Senate on June 10, 1974. However, Dr. Grady made a statement that he had received no receipts and made no expenditures for the period, but shows on the Report \$1,000.00 in contributions. Dr. Grady showed an ending balance on the prior Report of \$7,743.94. On this Report he shows a beginning balance of \$1,000.00. There is an obvious discrepancy of expenditures of these funds of approximately \$2,100.00. The Secretary of the Senate asked for additional information to correct errors and omissions on the Report, and this Report was filed on July 2, 1974, however it did not correct the discrepancy of the beginning balance of the period.

The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was on September 10, 1974. This Report was received by the Secretary of the Senate on September 10, 1974, however it was also marked as being filed late, having been received by the Secretary of the Senate on September 10, 1974. It was marked as being correct and complete, and was marked as being correct and complete. Dr. Grady's ending balance on the prior Report was \$1,000.00, however his beginning balance on this Report was \$1,000.00. This shows a discrepancy of approximately \$1,000.00 of reported contributions.

Subsequently, no other or most primary election reports were filed, as required by law.

The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was the pre-election Report for the general election, due 15 days before the election. Once again, Dr. Grady was issued a letter stating that he had errors and omissions, which must be corrected as soon as possible. His corrections were received by the Secretary of the Senate November 1, 1974. The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was the second pre-election Report due 5 days before the general election. However, this Report was not filed until after

Dr. Grady received a telegram from the Secretary of the Senate stating that he had failed to file a report. In response, Dr. Grady filed the Report on November 14, 1974. Once again, this Report was marked notification of errors and omissions" by the Secretary of the Senate. Mr. Grady filed the January 1975 Report for the period ending December 31, 1974, and was received by the Secretary of the Senate on February 1, 1975. Dr. Grady was notified of errors and omissions on this Report by the Secretary of the Senate, which included blatant violations of the law. In this report, he clearly identifies several contributions which were reportable in the 5 day pre-election Report, but were not reported until February, 1975. An example of this could be receipt of a contribution on 10/22/74 from W. Blair Makinney, 3324 Lucerne Avenue, Lake Worth, Florida 33460, who is a retired individual. Mr. Makinney contributed \$2,000.00. Repeatedly, throughout this Report, Dr. Grady failed to give the following information required by law: occupation, principal place of business of all contributors which aggregate year-end income in excess of \$100,000, the contributor's home address, and whether or not all individuals who contributed more than \$100.00 during the year-to-date were full-time employees.

During 1975, Dr. Grady filed only one Report, which covered the period 1/1/75 through 7/15/75. Due to changes in the law, had establishment of the Federal Election Commission, Dr. Grady would have been required to file with the FEC the following reports: 1/1/75 through 1/31/75 filed by 3/15/75 or 1/1/75 through 3/31/75 filed by 5/15/75 and 3/1/75 through 6/30/75 filed by 8/15/75, or 4/1/75 through 7/1/75 filed by 7/15/75. The only full report Dr. Grady could have filed for 1975 would have been the full year report for 1975, which would have been filed by 1/1/76 and received or extended more than 1,000.00 during that year. However, his Report filed for the reporting period of 1/1/75 through 7/15/75 (no such reporting period exists under the law) clearly shows that he had spent more than 1,000.00 in that period. Once again he had to be notified by the Secretary of the Senate that he had errors and omissions in the Report.

This is the last report filed by Dr. Grady, candidate for the United States Senate, as a member of the American Party. However, on his Report of 1/1/75 through 7/15/75, Dr. Grady shows loans received of \$8,517.24. Under the law, it is impossible for a Political Committee to terminate without liquidating all debts. Therefore, it can only be assumed that this Committee is still in existence, and is not reporting, which is clearly a violation of the law.

On May 13, 1976, Dr. Grady submitted a letter to the Federal Election Commission, stating his intention to qualify as a candidate for the United States Senate in 1976, and a declaration of assets. He stated that these intentions were discussed at a press conference held in Miami, Florida, January, 1976. However, Dr. Grady had previously told it known that he was a candidate for the United States Senate from the American Party prior to that time. According to the press releases, in Jan. 1976, he was the recipient of in kind contributions of the best available. No reports have been filed to all contributions and expenditures from 7/15/75 until 6/15/76 by Dr. Grady, as a candidate for the United States Senate in Florida.

On July 12, 1976, Dr. Gredy filed his first Campaign Report for his election as a member of the Republican Party to the United States Senate in Florida. He contended in several letters sent to the Federal Election Commission and the Secretary of the Senate that he was a newly established candidate of the Republican Party, however, he filed under the same identification number that he had used as a candidate of the American Party.

1. The March 10, 1974 Report was filed late. (Received 5/22/74.)
2. The June 10, 1974 Report was filed late. (Received 6/14/74.)

The beginning cash balance on the June 10 Report is \$2,143.54 lower than the ending balance on the March 10 Report. This is due to the fact that the amount reported as the cash on hand at the beginning of the reporting period for the June 10 Report was actually the total receipts that period. The candidate did not carry over the figures from the previous report.*

3. The September 10, 1974 Report was filed late. (Received 9/13/74.)

The beginning cash balance on the September 10 Report is \$7,798.54 higher than the ending balance on the June 10 Report. This is due to the fact that the beginning cash balance is correctly listed on this report and the figures are correctly carried over from the previous report.*

4. The 15 Day Pre-Election Report due 8/26/74 and the 5 Day Pre-Election Report due 9/5/74 for the 1974 primary election were not filed. Although these reports were never filed, there was no gap in coverage as the September 10, 1974 Report and the 15 Day Pre-Election Report for the General Election included the pre-primary periods.

5. The candidate designated the September 10, 1974 Report to also be a 15 Day Pre-Election Report for the 11/5/74 General Election. He was notified that the report would not be accepted as the Pre-Election Report and was sent a schedule of filing dates.

A report designated as the 15 Day and 5 Day Pre-Election Report for the

General Election covering the period 9/10/74 to 10/14/74 was received on 10/21/74. (The coverage dates are incorrect, but the candidate was not cited for this. Dates for the 15 Day Report should have been 9/1/74 to 10/21/74. Dates for the 5 Day Report should have been 10/22/74 to 10/31/74.) This report was not late.

The candidate was sent a Night Letter on 11/5/74 stating that a 5 Day Pre-General Election Report was required. A report covering the period 10/15/74 to 10/24/74 in response to the Night Letter was received 11/14/74 and accepted as a late filing. The report presumably was accepted as a 5 Day Pre-Election Report although the report identification was not indicated on the cover page of the report.

A report covering the period 10/24/74 to 12/31/74 designated as the January 31 Report was received 2/1/75. Contributions which should have been reported in the 5 Day Pre-General Election Report were listed (10/22/74 contributions). The occupation for contributors giving in excess of \$100 was omitted or inadequate for the majority and the principal place of business was omitted for all. The candidate was cited.

A partial amendment was received 3/20/75 disclosing the occupation and principal place of business for only three of the contributors. A copy of a letter mailed to all contributors asking for mailing address and occupation (not principal place of business) was included.

6. A compliance notification was sent to the candidate 4/25/75 as no March 10, 1975 Report was received. (Legal's memo incorrectly refers to 1976 documents when 1975 is intended.)

A report accepted as a late March 10 and a June 10 was received 7/24/75. This report covers the period 1/1/75 to 7/15/75. The closing balance of the report is (10¢). It is not indicated to be a Termination Report. (Loans reported received during this period were from the candidate himself and were used to pay up all expenses incurred by the candidate.)

7. No other reports were received until 7/23/76. This report covers the period 5/21/76 to 6/30/76. On 5/17/76 the candidate filed a statement of intent to qualify as a candidate for the 11/2/76 General Election (Senate). The cash on hand at the beginning of the reporting period is 0.

There are no gaps in coverage until 7/15/75 to 5/20/76, although responses may have late. I could find no indication that the candidate's last report in 1975 (the combined March 10 and June 10 Report) was considered a Termination Report, but also, I could find no indication that the candidate was notified for failure to file the September 10, 1975 and the January 31, 1976 Reports.

It should be noted that the candidate responded in part to all RFAI's. It appears that since no notifications of failure to file the September 10 and January 31 Reports were received by the candidate he believed that he was in compliance with the law.

Other reports and forms will be sent as soon as possible or when due. Let me assure you that we intend to keep complete and accurate records of all business and financial matters and transactions. Furthermore, we will make every effort to cooperate with the Federal Election Commission to the best of our ability, and we welcome your assistance and advice so that this campaign can be conducted properly in every regard. We do have some confusion over the changing status of the law, as well as the status of the FEC. It is our understanding that this campaign for the United States Senate is to be conducted entirely under the jurisdiction and supervision of the FEC and that we are not under the jurisdiction of state law. However, copies of this correspondence and attached forms and changes in appointments, etc., will also be filed with the Secretary of State in Tallahassee.

This letter is to serve as notice of an official complaint against Dr. John Grady, 800 S. Main, Belle Glade, Florida, (identification number C-458), for a number of apparent violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as Amended.

Each apparent violation listed should be construed as an individual complaint as such.

This series of complaints is being filed on the basis of the following apparent violations:

The first Report filed for Dr. Grady was the March 10, 1974, Report, which should have been mailed by March 10, 1974. It was received by the Secretary of the Senate May 22, 1974, and was appropriately marked "Late Filing." Dr. Grady marked on this Report a certification that he had not received any receipts, nor made any expenditures for that reporting period. However, within the Report itself, filed as a Candidate Report, he shows \$7,748.54 in receipts. There is no provision of the law which allows for late filing, since the intention of the law was to allow the public to see a timely report of receipts and expenditures.

Dr. Grady then filed a June 10, 1974, Report, which was to have been mailed by June 10, 1974, and apparently was received by the Secretary of the Senate on June 14, 1974. However, Dr. Grady once again marked that he had received no receipts and made no expenditures for the period, but shows on the Report \$5,605.00 in contributions. Dr. Grady showed an ending balance on the prior Report of \$7,748.54. On this Report he shows a beginning balance of \$5,605.00. There is an obvious discrepancy of expenditures of these funds of approximately \$2,100.00. The Secretary of the Senate asked for additional information to correct errors and omissions on the Report, and this Report was filed on July 8, 1974, however it did not correct the discrepancy of the beginning balance of the period.

The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was the September 10, 1974. This Report was to be in the mail no later than September 10, 1974, however it was also marked as being filed late, having been received by the Secretary of the Senate on September 19, 1974. It was marked as having errors and omissions, and requesting more information from the candidate. Dr. Grady's ending balance in the prior report was \$5,605.00, however his beginning balance on this Report was \$13,403.54. This shows a discrepancy of approximately \$7,000.00 of reported contributions.

Apparently, no pre or post primary election Reports were filed, as required by law.

The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was the Pre-election Report for the general election, due 15 days before the election. Once again, Dr. Grady was issued a letter stating that he had errors and omissions, which must be corrected as soon as possible. His corrections were received by the Secretary of the Senate November 7, 1974. The next Report filed by Dr. Grady was the second pre-election Report due 5 days before the general election. However, this Report was not filed until after

Dr. Grady received a telegram from the Secretary of the Senate stating that he had failed to file a Report. In response, Dr. Grady filed the Report on November 14, 1974. Once again, this Report was marked notification of errors and omissions" by the Secretary of the Senate. Mr. Grady filed the January 31st Report for the period ending December 31, 1974, and was received by the Secretary of the Senate on February 1, 1975. Dr. Grady was notified of errors and omissions on this Report by the Secretary of the Senate, which included blatant violations of the law. In this report, he clearly identifies several contributions which were reportable in the 5 day pre-election Report, but were not reported until February, 1975. An example of this would be receipt of a contribution on 10/22/74 from W. Blair Makinney, 3324 Lucerne Avenue, Lake Worth, Florida 33460, who is a retired individual. Mr. Makinney contributed \$2,000.00. Repeatedly, throughout this Report, Dr. Grady failed to give the following information required by law: occupation, principle place of business of all contributors which aggregate year-to-date more than \$100.00, the aggregate year-to-date total, and whether or not all individual contributors whose contributions exceeded \$100.00 aggregate year-to-date were self-employed.

During 1975, Dr. Grady filed only one Report, which covered the period 1/1/75 through 7/15/75. Due to changes in the law, and establishment of the Federal Election Commission, Dr. Grady would have been required to file under the following reporting periods: 1/1/75 through 2/28/75 filed by 3/10/75 or 1/1/75 through 3/31/75 filed by 4/10/75, and 3/1/75 through 5/31/75 filed by 6/10/75, or 4/1/75 through 6/30/75 filed by 7/10/75. The only legal reason Dr. Grady would have had for not filing the first full quarter Report for 1975 would have been if he had not received or expended more than \$1,000.00 during that calendar period. However, his Report filed for the mysterious period of 1/1/75 through 7/15/75 (no such reporting period exists under the law) clearly shows that he did expend more than \$1,000.00 in that period. Once again he had to be notified by the Secretary of the Senate that he had errors and omissions in the Report.

This is the last Report filed by Dr. Grady, candidate for the United States Senate, as a member of the American Party. However, on his Report of 1/1/75 through 7/15/75, Mr. Grady shows loans received of \$4,617.24. Under the law, it is impossible for a Political Committee to terminate without extinguishing all debts. Therefore, it can only be assumed that this Committee is still in existence, and is not reporting, which is clearly a violation of the law.

On May 13, 1976, Dr. Grady submitted a letter to the Federal Election Commission, stating his intentions to qualify as a candidate for the United States Senate in Florida, as a Republican candidate. He stated that these intentions were announced at a press conference held in Miami, Florida, Sunday, May 9, 1976. However, Dr. Grady had publicly made it known that he was a candidate for the United States Senate from the American Party prior to that time. According to the press releases, in Feb. 1976, he was the recipient of in kind contributions of the beef provided. No reports have been seen at all concerning any expenditures from 7/15/75 until 5/13/76 by Dr. Grady, as a candidate for the United States Senate in Florida.

He contended in several letters sent to the Federal Election Commission and the Secretary of the Senate that he was a newly established candidate of the Republican Party, however, he filed under the same identification number that he had used as a candidate of the American Party.
