

Analysis and Recommendation

Respondent Association is a labor organization and subject to the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §441b and 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C). However, since the costs of the letter of October 27, 1976 advocating the election of a clearly identified candidate did not exceed \$2,000, there is no disclosure obligation under 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C) by the labor union. Thus, there is no reason to believe that the labor union has violated the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §431 (f)(4)(C).

It should be noted that the political action committee, according to respondent, solicited "anyone and everyone" in the sale of raffle tickets. 2 U.S.C. §441b(b)(4)(A)(ii) makes it unlawful for a labor organization or a separate segregated fund established by a labor organization to solicit contributions to the fund from persons other than its members and their families.

Based upon communications with respondents, it appears that the organization is unfamiliar with the provisions of the Act. Under the circumstances, the solicitation of persons outside the membership and families of members appears to have been accidental or inadvertent. See §114.5(h), regulations.

I. Allegations

1. Daniel C. Mooney filed a notarized complaint on November 29, 1976, alleging that the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. (hereinafter Association) may have violated the Act by sending a letter to its members advocating the election of Howard T. Hogan, a Federal candidate.

2. In the course of reviewing this matter, a check of Howard T. Hogan's reports failed to disclose an in-kind contribution from the Association's political action fund.

II. Evidence

1. Complainant submitted a copy of the letter at issue which was dated October 27, 1976. He stated in his complaint that the letter was sent to all members of the Association in the third Congressional District. He also indicated that the Association was an incorporated labor union.

Respondent initially replied on February 14, 1977 through its President, Irving Flaumenbaum. In that communication, he attached copies of two bills which were paid in connection with the campaign of Howard T. Hogan, Jr. These bills indicated

that a total of \$399.60 was spent on behalf of Mr. Hogan's candidacy. One bill was for printed letters, the other for "sho card signs."

This letter also indicated that the printed matter was given to the candidate and that the preparation of the letters was performed by the candidate and/or his committee.

Further inquiries to respondent revealed that the funds used to support the candidacy of Mr. Hogan were proceeds from a raffle sponsored by the Association's political action fund and no part of the \$399.60 came from membership dues.

2. A review of Mr. Hogan's campaign reports and those filed by his Committee did not reflect receipt of the value of the contributed amount as reported by the Association herein. The facts as presented do not support a finding that the Association made independent expenditures on behalf of Mr. Hogan. Thus, the Commission on May 5, 1977, found reason to believe Howard T. Hogan committed a violation of the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §434(b) and communicated this finding on May 16, 1977. Mr. Hogan responded on May 25, 1977, indicating his willingness to file amended reports to reflect the in-kind contributions. (See letter attached).

On June 21, 1977, respondent Hogan, through counsel, submitted amended reports for the 1976 October 10 quarterly, ten-day pre-election, 30-day post-election and year end reports. (See attached cover letters submitted with the reports).

III. Analysis and Recommendation

Respondent Association is a labor organization and subject to the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §441b and 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C). Since the union did not pay out of dues money the costs of the letter of October 27, 1976 advocating the election of a clearly identified candidate, there is no disclosure obligation under 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C) by the labor union. Thus, there is no reason to believe that the labor union has violated the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C)

It should be noted that the political action committee, according to respondent, solicited "anyone and everyone" in the sale of raffle tickets. 2 U.S.C. §441b(b)(4)(A)(ii) makes it unlawful for a labor organization or a separate segregated fund established by a labor organization to solicit contributions to the fund from persons other than its members and their families.

Based upon communications with respondent, it appears that the organization is unfamiliar with the provisions of the Act. Under the circumstances, the solicitation from persons outside the membership and families of members appears to have been based on ignorance of the law. Cf. §114.5(h), Proposed Regulations (accidental or inadvertent solicitation not a violation).

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
No further action is recommended in this case with respect to the Association, however, it will be advised of the specific prohibitions regarding solicitations.

Respondent Hogan's amended reports disclose both in-kind contributions by the Association. Based upon the voluntary compliance by this respondent, it is recommended that no further action be taken.


Thank you for your letter of May 16, 1977,



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Allegation

Daniel C. Mooney filed a notarized complaint on November 29, 1976, alleging that the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. (hereinafter Association) may have violated the Act by sending a letter to its members advocating the election of a Federal candidate.

II. Evidence

Complainant submitted a copy of the letter at issue which was dated October 27, 1976, (a copy is attached). He stated in his complaint that the letter was sent to all members of the Association in the third Congressional District. He also indicated that the Association was an incorporated labor union.

Respondent initially replied on February 14, 1977, through its President, Irving Flaumenbaum. In that communication, he attached copies of two bills which were paid in connection with the campaign of Howard T. Hogan, Jr. (See attached). These bills indicated that a total

of \$399.60 was spent on behalf of Mr. Hogan's candidacy. One bill was for printed letters, the other for "sho card signs."

This letter also indicated that the printed matter was given to the candidate and that the preparation of the letters was performed by the candidate and/or his committee and postage borne by the candidate and/or his committee.

Further inquiries to respondent revealed that the funds used to support the candidacy of Mr. Hogan were proceeds from a raffle sponsored by the Association's political action fund and no part of the \$399.60 came from membership dues. (See letters from respondent dated February 18, and March 10, 1977, attached hereto).

III. Analysis and Recommendation

Respondent is a labor organization and subject to the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §441b and 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C). Since the union did not pay out of dues money the costs of the letter of October 27, 1976 advocating the election of a clearly identified candidate, there is no disclosure obligation under 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C) by the labor union. Thus, there is no reason to believe that the labor union has violated the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C).

It should be noted that the political action Committee, according to respondent, solicited "anyone and everyone" in the sale of raffle tickets. 2 U.S.C. §441b(b)(4)(A)(ii) makes it unlawful for a labor organization or a separate segregated fund established by a labor organization to solicit contributions to the fund from persons other than its members and their families.

Based upon communications with respondent, it appears that the organization is unfamiliar with the provisions of the Act. Under the circumstances, the solicitation from persons outside the membership and families of members appears to have been based on ignorance of the law. Cf. §114.5(h), Proposed Regulations (accidental or inadvertent solicitation not a violation).


No further action is recommended in this case with respect to the Association, however, it will be advised of the specific prohibitions regarding solicitations.

A review of Mr. Hogan's campaign reports and those filed by his Committee do not reflect receipt of the value of the contributed amount as reported by the Association herein. The facts as presented do not support a finding that the Association made independent expenditures on behalf of Mr. Hogan. It is, therefore, recommended that the Commission find

reason to believe Howard T. Hogan committed a violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b) by failing to report the \$399.60 in-kind contribution from the Association.

V. Conclusion

Find reason to believe against Howard T. Hogan. Send attached letter.






This is in answer to our telephone conversation of





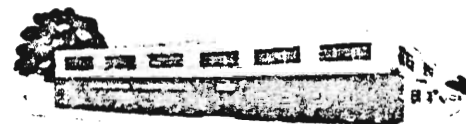

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

(CONTINUED)

The Commission's proposed regulations (§§109.1(1) and 109.5) interpret the provisions of 2 U.S.C. §434(e) as not applying to corporations and labor unions.

Complainant does not indicate the size of the membership of respondent but assumes the threshold reporting obligation to be in excess of \$100. Since it is possible, however, that the costs exceeded \$2,000 (a membership of 16,000 would bring postage costs to \$2,080), we recommend that the Commission find reason to believe a violation may have occurred.



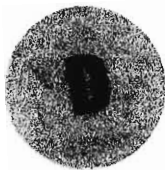
