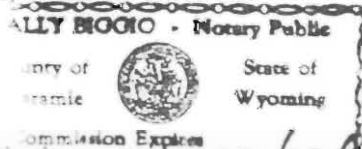
I enclose photo copies of envelopes in which the materials were sent. Also, I am copying the persons who complained to this office. I would ask the FEC to investigate this violation.

# REPUBLICAN VERSUS DEMOCRATIC PLATFORMS:

## Family Values

A key term in Campaign '92 has been "family values." The Republican party and the Democratic party define this term in different ways and represent two sides in the "culture war" over values in our society.

### Republican Platform Key Points

1. *Abortion:* "We believe the unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed. We therefore affirm our support for a human life amendment to the Constitution, and... we affirm our support for appointment of judges who respect traditional family values and the sanctity of innocent human life." George Bush will veto the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) which would prevent states from restricting abortion. Supports Title X regulations on abortion, supports ban on fetal tissue experimentation, and supports ban on RU-486 pill.

2. *Families:* "For more than three decades, the liberal philosophy has assaulted the family on every side... Republicans trust parents and believe they, not courts and lawyers, know what is best for their children." The platform opposes legislation "which legally recognizes same-sex marriages and allows such couples to adopt children and provide foster care."

3. *Gay Rights:* Supports ban on homosexuals in the military. Opposes special laws to force employers, churches, and others to accommodate gay "rights."

4. *Education:* Advocates a voucher system which allows parents to choose public, private, or parochial schools. Favors competency testing standards and block grants to schools with innovative approaches.

5. *Sex education:* George Bush believes "that the family and not the school must continue to assume the primary responsibility for the transmission of religious, moral, and cultural values." Encourages parental involvement in the lives of their adolescents.

6. *Family leave:* Supports voluntary family leave programs, but opposes mandatory parental leave bills in Congress. Supports expanding child-care credits in 1990, but opposes a national day care program. Proposes tax credits or vouchers to meet child care needs.

7. *Welfare:* Supports tax breaks for businesses investing in poor neighborhood "enterprise zones." Proposes programs which encourage welfare recipients to work or receive job training.

### Democratic Platform Key Points

1. *Abortion:* The platform stands "behind the right of every woman to choose, consistent with Roe vs. Wade, regardless of ability to pay." The goal should be to "make abortion less necessary, not more difficult or more dangerous." Bill Clinton supports the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA) which would prevent states from restricting abortion. Opposes Title X regulations on abortion, and opposes ban on fetal tissue experimentation.

2. *Families:* "Governments don't raise children, people do... Children should not have children. We need a national crackdown on deadbeat parents, an effective system of child-support enforcement."

3. *Gay Rights:* Would overturn Pentagon ban on homosexuals in military. Supports adding "sexual orientation" as classification in civil rights suits.

4. *Education:* Opposes vouchers that would finance private and parochial schools. Proposes college loan program which students could repay through a portion of their income or through a national service program.

5. *Sex education:* Supports school-based health clinics that provide reproductive health services including dispensing birth control pills and devices.

6. *Family leave:* Favors mandatory parental leave bills. Bill Clinton backed state-funded day care in Arkansas and would support similar national proposals.

7. *Welfare:* Proposes community-based development banks which would provide small-business loans in poor neighborhoods. Would expand education and training for those on welfare. Would require able-bodied recipients to work after getting two years' benefits. Increase earned income credit for poor parents. [ ]



We are in receipt of your letter dated April 7 some four months after a complaint was lodged against us. The number your office has assigned to this matter is [REDACTED]. Of the numerous pages sent to us in the complaint we have previously only seen the first two, (sides one & two of the enclosed piece.) We did send the piece in question to Mr. and Mrs. Ruben Jenkins. We do not know the other persons who apparently complained to the FEC about other literature which they received. We did not mail this information to Wyoming cities outside the Casper area.

We believe that no action should be taken against us in this matter for the following reasons:

1. We were exercising our First Amendment rights guaranteed under the United States Constitution to both freedom of speech and freedom of religion. We sent a piece of literature which we had received to some of our friends and acquaintances with the following enclosed disclaimer in each envelope, "This information does not purport to represent any church, political party, or other organization, but it does reflect our personal views concerning the upcoming election." Mary & Maureen Enrich.

The literature which we deemed primarily religious in nature due to the large number of Scripture quotations carried a permission to distribute notation on the back. We sent it first class in the U.S. mail with our name on the envelope so that the recipients would know that we were choosing to make our views known to them on a matter which we considered important. It should have been obvious to the recipients since we paid the postage that we had also paid for the copies which we had sent.

2. There was no intent to violate any law, state or federal
3. There was no intent to offend anyone of our acquaintances, and several who did receive it telephoned to voice their appreciation that we had taken the time to share the information with them. Mr. Jenkins whom we have known for about thirty years did telephone to express his disagreement with our opinion. We accepted that as his First Amendment

right to express his opinion.

4. There was no mass distribution of this piece or any of the other pieces cited by us.
5. Even though there was an apparent oversight on the part of the FEC about notifying us within the required five days of a complaint, four months does seem like a very long time beyond the required five days to notify someone that one recipient of a personal letter was displeased with its contents.
6. Since the FEC requires that complaints are to be notarized, and Mr. Jenkins did not comply with that requirement, his complaint should be dismissed.

If you need further documentation or sworn statements from our friends who received our personal first class mailing with the aforementioned disclaimer, please do not hesitate to contact us. At the present time we are not retaining counsel in this matter but will retain our right to do so in the future if it becomes necessary.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S QUARTERLY REPORT

I. INTRODUCTION

This report is the second Enforcement Priority System Quarterly Report. The purpose of this Quarterly Report is to recommend that the Commission no longer pursue the identified lower priority and stale cases.

II. CASES RECOMMENDED FOR CLOSING

A. Cases Not Warranting Further Pursuit Relative to Other Cases Pending Before the Commission

A critical component of the Priority System is identifying those pending cases that do not warrant the further expenditure of resources. Each incoming matter is evaluated using Commission approved criteria

By closing such cases the Commission is able to use its limited resources to focus on more important cases.

Having evaluated incoming matters, this Office has identified 16 cases which do not warrant further pursuit relative to the other pending cases.<sup>1</sup> A short

#### B. Stale Cases

Investigations are severely impeded and require relatively more resources when the activity and evidence are old. Such efforts will also generate more impact on the current electoral process and are a more efficient allocation of our limited resources. To this end, this Office has identified 42 cases that
