Dear Ms. Odrowski:

We received by facsimile on May 22, 1997 and by FedEx on May 23 your letter dated May 22 and the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") Subpoena dated May 22. I dictate this letter from Arizona, where I am on a combination business and Mayo Clinic trip, presently scheduled to return on June 5 and no way likely to return sooner. Hence, the June 4 date would be unacceptable.

However, as I have explained to you by telephone, and as further set out in some detail in our letter to you of April 25, 1997, we will not advise Mr. Eric M. Licht to appear for the taking of his deposition until and unless the United States District Court so orders and, if accorded the opportunity, we shall oppose any FEC effort to seek such an order.

On May 27, 1997 our office received by facsimile from Lawrence M. Noble, Esquire, General Counsel, FEC, a copy of his letter of May 27 to Judge Joyce Hens Green. We do not represent the National Right to Work Committee in MUR 3774 or otherwise but only Coalitions for America, Inc., of which Mr. Eric M. Licht is President. Presumably there is a reason why FEC has favored us with a copy -- and a marked copy at that -- of the Noble letter to Judge Green. Neither we nor our client has been a party


