**COMPLAINT OF CENTER FOR RESPONSIVE POLITICS**

1. This complaint charges that the respondent has violated the Federal Election Campaign Act, 2 U.S.C. § 431 et seq., as amended ("FECA"), by making aggregate contributions in excess of the limits permitted by the FECA.

**PARTIES**

2. The complainant, the Center for Responsive Politics, is a nonprofit, nonpartisan research group incorporated in the State of Iowa and headquartered in Washington, D.C., that studies Congress and related issues. Founded in 1983, it was designed to research matters concerning the organization and operation of Congress as an institution and to examine potential reforms that could improve both its internal operation and its responsiveness to the American public. The patterns of contributions of money to federal candidates has been one of its chief areas of study.

3. The respondent is an individual contributor to various candidates and political committees.

**APPLICABLE STATUTES AND REGULATIONS**

4. The FECA limits contributions by any one individual to an aggregate total of \$25,000 per calendar year. Contributions to a candidate or the candidate's authorized committee made in a year other than the calendar year of the election with respect to which the contribution is made are considered to be made during the calendar year in which such election is held. 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(3); 11 C.F.R. § 110.5.


**GROUND FOR COMPLAINT**

5. According to FEC records, respondent Chesley Pruet made contributions subject to FECA in the amounts and to the persons identified in the list attached to this complaint as Exhibit 1. Attached as Exhibit 2 are copies of the FEC records for each contribution listed in Exhibit 1. All exhibits reflect the records on file at the FEC as of December 15, 1993.
6. On information and belief, respondent Chesley Pruet made contributions attributed to the 1992 calendar year in the amount of \$39,200. These contributions exceeded by \$14,200 the \$25,000 contribution limit imposed by the FECA and Commission regulations on all contributions by any individual in a calendar year.

**RELIEF**

7. The Center for Responsive Politics respectfully urges the Commission to conduct a prompt and thorough investigation into the allegations in this Complaint, and to declare that the Respondent has violated the FECA and Commission regulations.

This is in response to the complaint filed by the Center For Responsive Politics (complainant) referred to in the above captioned matter, alleging a violation of the individual annual aggregate contribution limit (2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(3)) by respondent.

In fact, no such violation occurred. The complaint is based on a review of a summary of FEC data prepared by the complainant which is erroneous (see Exhibit 1, attached).

1. **Contributions to the Republican Party Of Arkansas**

The complainant's summary indicates contributions by the respondent to the Republican Party Of Arkansas (federal account) of \$15,200. The respondent contends that \$15,000 of this amount was contributed for state and local campaign activity in Arkansas, and should not be attributed to the Republican Party of Arkansas federal account.

In fact, the Party amended its 1992 July FEC monthly report deleting its mistaken attribution to its federal account of a \$10,000 contribution by respondent on July 2, 1992, which is still listed as a federal contribution in the complainant's summary. (See Republican Party Of Arkansas FEC Amendment Exhibit 2, attached).

It is respondent's contention that the \$5,000 contribution to the Arkansas Republican Party, made on July 8, 1992, was also intended for non-federal activity and was mistakenly attributed to the federal account by the Party and reported on its July 1992 FEC Report. Although the Party is unable to verify respondent's assertion as to the non-federal nature of the contribution because of a change of administration within the Republican Party Of Arkansas, it has, nevertheless, refunded respondent's \$5,000 as requested.

It is unclear whether the \$200 donation contributed by respondent on October 13, 1992, was to attend a federal or non-federal Party fund-raiser, therefore, the respondent does not contest the federal attribution by the Arkansas Republican Party.

2. **Contributions to George Bush**

The complainant's summary indicates three contributions to the George Bush Campaign by respondent. The respondent made only one contribution to the Bush campaign on 1/6/92. A contribution was also made by Mrs. Pruet on that date. Respondent contributed \$1,000 to the Bush/Quayle legal and compliance fund on 1/6/92. Therefore, the additional \$1,000 contribution listed on complainant's summary as being received by the Bush Campaign from the respondent on 1/14/92 should *not* be attributed to respondent.


**Conclusion:**

Based upon the above facts, it is clear from the record that the annual aggregate contribution limit was not exceeded by respondent since contributions attributable to the respondent's 1992 federal aggregate limit amount to \$23,200. Therefore, the Federal Election Commission should



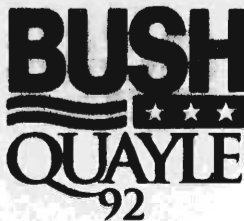

GENERAL COUNSEL'S MONTHLY REPORT

**SENSITIVE**

I. INTRODUCTION

This report is the second Enforcement Priority System Monthly Report. The purpose of this September Monthly Report is to recommend that the Commission no longer pursue the identified lower priority and stale cases.

II. CASES RECOMMENDED FOR CLOSING

A. Cases Not Warranting Further Pursuit Relative to Other Cases Pending Before the Commission

A critical component of the Priority System is identifying those pending cases that do not warrant the further expenditure of resources. Each incoming matter is evaluated using Commission-approved criteria and cases that, based on their rating, do not warrant pursuit relative to other pending cases are placed in this category. By closing such cases, the Commission is able to use its limited resources to focus on more important cases.

Having evaluated incoming matters, this Office has identified 44 cases which do not warrant further pursuit

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relative to the other pending cases.<sup>1</sup> A short description of each case and the factors leading to assignment of a relatively low priority and consequent recommendation not to pursue each case is attached to this report. See Attachments 1-44. For the Commission's convenience, the narratives for the externally-generated matters are immediately followed by the complaint and response(s) and the narrative for the internally-generated matter is immediately followed by the referral.

#### B. Stale Cases

Investigations are severely impeded and require relatively more resources when the activity and evidence are old. Consequently, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission focus its efforts on cases involving more recent activity. Such efforts will also generate more impact on the current electoral process and are a more efficient allocation of our limited resources. To this end, this Office has identified 2 cases that have remained inactive and assigned to the Central Enforcement Docket for one year and which it believes do not warrant further investment of significant Commission resources.<sup>2</sup> Since the recommendation not to pursue the identified cases is

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
