Recent news stories have validated what we at the Legal Affairs Council have suspected for some time. The Clinton/Gore election campaign, while pretending to be paragons of virtue, has been spending taxpayer funds illegally for certain "personal" expenses of Mr. Richard Morris, President Clinton's closest political advisor.

While espousing "family values," the campaign has been reimbursing Mr. Morris for expenses directly related to criminal activities, namely engaging in prostitution at the Jefferson Hotel in Washington, DC, and in other unknown places, in a total amount yet undetermined. It is incumbent on your commission to ferret out the truth from the Clinton/Gore campaign as to the total amount of taxpayer money spent on sex, liquor and lodging for Mr. Morris and prostitute Sherry Rowlands (and potentially others). We would also expect that your commission will conduct a thorough investigation to determine the identities of additional prostitutes with whom Mr. Morris may have engaged in taxpayer-subsidized sexual acts, and the amount of taxpayer funds spent thereon.



Of the \$200,000 plus that has been paid to Mr. Morris, the Clinton/Gore campaign admits that \$27,000 of these funds are directly attributable to activities at the Jefferson Hotel. Ms. Rowlands admits payment of \$12, 000 as payment for her to engage in sexual intercourse and other sexual acts with Mr. Morris. The question the American people expect you to answer is - How much taxpayer money was spent by the Clinton/Gore campaign to further these sordid activities?

We expect your investigation to be speedy and thorough. Further, if the newspaper reports are correct, we anticipate the FEC requiring reimbursement of taxpayer funds from the Clinton/Gore campaign and appropriate financial penalties to be levied. This should not hang like a cloud over the coming presidential election.
