
This payment will close this matter out between our campaign and the Federal Election Commission. I appreciate the professional

III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File Forty-Eight Hour Notifications

Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate ("the Committee") has failed to file 48-Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") totaling \$39,500 received prior to the 1996 General Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1996 Alabama General Election held on November 5, 1996. Prior Notice was sent to the Committee on September 30, 1996 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "48 Hour Notices on Contributions". This section reads "Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of October 17 through November 2. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s)."

Schedule A of the 1996 30 Day Post-General Report indicates that the Committee has failed to file 48-Hour Notices for contributions received during the aforementioned period (Attachment 3). The following are the contributions, as reported by the Committee, for which 48-Hour Notices were not filed:

On February 11, 1997, a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee (Attachment 4). The RFAI notes on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notice requests the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time period. In addition, the notice states that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

On April 11, 1997, Brannon Walden, a Committee representative, telephoned a Reports Analysis Division analyst regarding the 48-Hour Notices. Mr. Walden advised the analyst that there may have been a computer error and wanted to know how to respond (Attachment 5). The analyst advised Mr. Walden to send in a letter explaining the failure to file the required 48-Hour Notices.

On April 21, 1997, the Committee filed a response with the Commission, which states that "contributions were unintentionally left out" and that the Committee "did not intend to withhold these contributions for full public disclosure" [emphasis added by Committee]. Included with the response were copies of previously filed 48 Hour Notices, copies of fax acknowledgement of receipt sheets from the Office of Public Records of the United States Senate and 48 Hour Notices for those contributions not reported timely (Attachment 6).

The attachment contains only copies of 48 Hour Notices and Fax Acknowledgement sheets from the Secretary of the Senate which are pertinent to the missing 48 Hour Notices.

If the campaign has an authorized committee(s), in addition to the principal campaign committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report on Form 32 and attach the report(s) of the authorized committee(s).

48 HOUR NOTICES ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including in-kind gifts or advances of goods or services; loans from the candidate or other non-bank sources; and guarantees or endorsements of loans to the candidate or committee) of \$1,000 or more, during the period October 17 through November 2.

The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s). U.S. House candidates faxing 48-hour notices should transmit them to the FEC at 202/219-0174. Senate candidates should transmit them to the Secretary of the Senate at 202/224-1851. Note that 48-hour notices are the only FEC documents that may be faxed.

LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Corrections should be made on the label.

COMPLIANCE

Treasurers of political committees are responsible for filing all reports on time. Failure to do so is subject to enforcement action. Committees filing illegible reports or using non-FEC forms (except for FEC approved computer generated forms) will be required to refile.

*These dates indicate the beginning and the end of the reporting period. A reporting period always begins the day after the closing date of the last report filed. If the committee is new and has not previously filed a report, the first report must cover all activity that occurred before the committee registered and, if applicable, before the individual became a candidate.

**Reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked by the mailing date; otherwise, they must be received by the filing date.

-You must attempt to obtain the occupation and name of employer for all individuals who contribute more than \$200 in a calendar year.

A committee may establish "best efforts" by providing the Commission with a description of its procedures for requesting the information and may also supply a copy of a solicitation. I. GENERATION OF MATTER

The Office of the General Counsel received a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on March 25, 1996. The basis for the attached referral is the failure of Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate, and Roger H. Bedford, as treasurer,¹ ("Committee") to file thirty-four (34) forty-eight hour notifications ("48 Hour Notices") for contributions totaling \$39,500. Roger H. Bedford lost the 1996 General Election for the Senate in the State of Alabama receiving forty-six percent (46%) of the vote.

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

Based on the Factual and Legal Analysis, see Attachment 1, this Office recommends the Commission find reason to believe the Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

¹ Roger H. Bedford is the current treasurer for the Committee. Prior to April 3, 1997, the treasurer for the Committee was Richard Todd.

On November 4, 1997, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath. In the absence of additional information, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation, and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, ("the Act") requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify, in writing, either the Secretary of the Senate or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State of the appropriate state, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election.

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. *Id.* The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements.

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

According to its Statement of Organization filed with the Commission, Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate ("the Committee") is the principal campaign committee of Roger Hugh Bedford,

a Senatorial candidate in the State of Alabama. Roger H. Bedford is the treasurer of the Committee according to its amended Statement of Organization dated April 4, 1997.

The 1996 General Election for the Senate in the state of Alabama was held on November 5, 1996. Pursuant to the Act, the Committee was required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 17, 1996 through November 2, 1996, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1996 30 Day Post-General Report identifies thirty-four (34) contributions received during the period of October 17, 1996 through November 2, 1996, totaling \$39,500 for which 48 Hour Notices were not filed. The Committee failed to submit the required 48 Hour Notices for these contributions.

Therefore, there is reason to believe that Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate, and Roger H. Bedford, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) by failing to report campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more, received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the General Election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions.



If the committee is new and has not previously filed a report, the first report must cover all activity that occurred before the committee registered and, if applicable, before the individual became a candidate.





CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate and Roger H. Bedford, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

- I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).
- II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.
- IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 1. Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is the authorized principal campaign committee for Roger H. Bedford's 1996 senatorial campaign in the State of Alabama.
 2. Roger H. Bedford is the treasurer of Roger H. Bedford for U.S. Senate.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify, in writing, either the Secretary of the Senate or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State of the appropriate state, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election.

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. *Id.* The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements.

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

4. Between October 17, 1996 and November 2, 1996, Respondents received thirty-four contributions totaling \$39,500.

5. These contributions were reported on Respondents' Schedule A of the 1996 30 Day Post-General Report.

6. Accordingly, Respondents should have filed 48 Hour Notices for these contributions no later than 48 hours after the receipt of the contributions.

7. Respondents failed to submit 48 Hour Notices for these contributions.

V. The Respondents failed to report campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the 1996 General Election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contribution, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Five Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 217 S.C.

§ 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.




