On November 3, 1998, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On October 21, 1999, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, that there is no reason to believe you violated any provision of the Act in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to you.

This matter will become part of the public record within 30 days after it has been closed with respect to all other respondents involved.
